2013 THE AUSTRALIAN SENIOR MEDAL

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. THE AUSTRALIAN SENIOR MEDAL:

- 1.1 The Australian Senior Medal will be played over 18 holes of stroke play on Tuesday 21st May 2013. Tees: Club Course (White)
- 1.2 Is open to those male Amateur golfers with an Australian Mens Handicap not exceeding 8.4 at the time of entry and that have attained the age of 55 years or over as at 21st May 2013.
- 1.3 Should entries be received in excess of the capacity as determined by the Match Committee, in the first instance players whom are playing in all three National Senior Ranking Events (The Lakes / The Australian / Avondale) will be excluded from the following ballot: Players with higher handicaps at the time of close of entries will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded (i.e. Those players with higher handicaps, but that have entered all three events will be given priority in the ballot over those with lower handicaps that have solely entered The Australian Senior Medal)
- 2. THE MATCH COMMITTEE: The Australian Golf Club Match Committee shall have sole management and control of The Australian Senior Medal. The decision of the Match Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3. TIES: In the event of a tie or ties for The Australian Senior Medal, unless the Match Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Match Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined. All other trophies will be decided by the Australian Count back System.
- 4. **RULES**: The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules as are approved by the Match Committee.
- 5. USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES: During The Australian Senior Medal, competitors may not travel in or on any motorized vehicle unless authorized by the Match Committee. Exceptions to the condition may be granted where a player suffers from a disability that would preclude him from competing in the event without the use of a motorized vehicle. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CONDITION: In the absence of an exemption two strokes at each hole at which a breach of this condition occurred; maximum penalty per round four strokes.

- 6. **DRIVING CLUBS:** "Any driver the player carries must have a club head, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R&A. Exception: A driver with a club head that was manufactured prior to 1999 is exempt from this condition.
 - *PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Stroke play –
 - Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round Four strokes. *Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to his marker or a fellow-competitor immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, he is disqualified.
 - *PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification."
- 7. PACE OF PLAY: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Players who fail to maintain their place in the field may be penalized for a breach of Rule 6-7.
- 8. **MOBILE PHONES**: The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during the play of any competition round is prohibited. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.
- 9. **RESULTS OF THE COMPETITION** COMPETITION CLOSED:

The competition is closed when all scores have been approved by the Match Committee.
