## PLAYER INFORMATION

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### Practice rounds

Practice rounds will be available at Mudgee Golf Club prior to the event. For bookings please call Mudgee Golf Club on (02) 6372 1811.

### Format

Saturday – Play will be from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee, commencing at 8.30am. 18-Holes Fourball Best Ball Stableford  
Sunday – Shotgun start at 9.30am. Irish Fourball (a best ball format played with Stableford points where the best single score is recorded on all Par 5's; the best two scores are recorded on all Par 4's and the best three scores are recorded on all Par 3's).

### Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card and any local rules will be given to you on the tee.

### Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at [www.golfnsw.org](http://www.golfnsw.org).

### Scorecards

Players are advised autoscore scorecards will be in use for this event. When signing these cards (on the back of the scorecard), you will be signing for the correctness of the scores as marked in the written number area of the card, as this is the score to count. Players must also mark off the corresponding score in the "lotto style" scoring area.

### Rules officials

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

### Food and Beverage

Mudgee Golf Club will be open each day for breakfast. Bacon and egg rolls, coffee and juice will be available for purchase for breakfast. A standard lunch menu will be available when you come off course. Mudgee Golf Club is providing these services specifically for this event, therefore we would encourage you to have your breakfast and lunch at the Club.

### Saturday evening dinner

This will be held in the Clubhouse, from 6.30pm, and will be a two-course meal. All entrants are welcome to attend this event. ## Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
