OUTBACK OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2013



- This Championship is a stroke round played over 36 holes for Male & Female Golfers : -
 - 1st Round Saturday July 20 July 2013
 - 2nd Round Sunday July 21 July 2013
 - Open tee times for males - Seeded Draw for ladies – Match & Greens Committee reserves the right to alter grouping to accommodate all players.
- Participants must hold a current GA handicap – **proof of handicap** will be required prior to commencement of event, also **proof that you are a financial member of a recognised GA golf club. This is an Amateur Event.**
- The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrews, together with local rules of the Broken Hill Golf & Country Club Ltd and Rules of GA. The Match Committee of the BHG & CC to be the absolute umpire in any dispute or protest lodged. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter, change or shorten the championship, should they deem it necessary.
- Starting handicaps of competitors will prevail over the 36 holes played. Players will finish in the Grade in which they started from in the first round of the Outback Open despite any handicap adjustments. The player will use their adjusted handicap for each concluded round of the championship, but retain their original handicap as at the beginning of the Outback Open for the 36 hole event.
- **All Competitors must nominate by 5.00pm Wednesday 17 July 2013 on the starting sheet in the Golf Shop or with the Golf Shop staff by post, fax email. Post Entries accepted.**
- **Competitors must report to the starter 10 minutes prior to starting time or risk disqualification.**
- **\$40.00 entry fee must be paid prior to commencement of event. Juniors under 18 will Pay \$20.00. "Reciprocal Rights" costs NOT APPLICABLE for this event.**
- Trophies will be awarded as follows : -
 - **36 Hole Championship – One major trophy only per player**
 - *Men - Gross Winner and Gross Runner Up in each Grade A, B & C*
 - *Men - Nett Winner and Nett Runner Up in each Grade A, B & C***Gross takes precedence over Nett**
- *Ladies –Trophies and Grades - **DEPENDENT ON NOMINATIONS***
Gross takes precedence over Nett
- If there is a tie in any of the Handicap Events a countback will be done as per GA countback system.
- In the event of a tie over 36 holes Gross Championship Event, a Sudden Death Play Off will decide the winner of each grade if required; Play Off hole will be the 1st Hole. If the conditions prevent a play off the GA countback system will be used.
- Motorised buggies may be used as per the **BHG & CC Ltd Buggy Policy**
- Handicaps and Grades :
Men - A Grade 0 - 11 B Grade 12 -18 C Grade 19 - 36
Ladies - **GRADES DEPENDANT ON NOMINATIONS**
- Eclectic, Birdie Box and Nearest the Pins on all par 3's are available for duration of Outback Open. Juniors Not Eligible for Birdie Box.
