Club Level Rules certification

Rules Accreditation

Since 1990, Golf Victoria has conducted the very popular Club Level Rules of Golf Accreditation Course. A State Level Accreditation Course was added in 1993. In addition, currently Golf Victoria conducts rules education nights for golf clubs throughout the calendar year.

Club Level Program

Club Level Rules of Golf Workshops are presented by members of Golf Victoria's Rules Committee over a period of approximately three hours. Each Workshop covers the following areas:-

- Rules Resources.
- How to use the Rules Book.
- Language of the Rules specifically Definitions, notes and exceptions.
- Illustration of the Rules of Golf (including 2012 changes).
- Question and Answer Session.
- Exam preparation.

At all stages, participants are encouraged to ask whatever Rules question they have. Whilst the workshops are an important learning forum for those persons who wish to undertake the Club Level Exam, there is no obligation to sit for the examination after attending the workshop.

The Club Level Exam involves a 50 multiple-choice question exam on the Rules of Golf. To pass, a minimum of 40 correct answers must be given. There is a time limit of three hours and Rules of Golf books may be used during the examination. Successful candidates will receive a Club Level Rules Accreditation Certificate of Achievement.

Persons remaining accredited receive a quarterly newsletter containing rules decisions received from the R&A Rules Ltd, Golf Australia or any decisions given by the Golf Victoria Rules Committee. Affiliated Clubs, Country Districts and Leagues are also encouraged to utilise Club Level Accredited persons when requiring rules officials for major club/district events.

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PGA Training School

- ✓ Community Coach 2 candidate will be required to attend specific sessions of Year 1 and Year 2 PGA Training Schools
- ✓ The PGA Academy will structure Training Schools in a convenient fashion for possible Community Golf Coach 2 candidates
- ✓ Community Golf Coach 2 candidates will be required to complete knowledge based assessments relating to each of the Training School sessions
