- <u>Entries close Friday 7th September 2013 at 7:30pm.</u> No late entries will be accepted however the Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept late entries in special circumstances.
- Green & competition fees are included in the entry fee.
- The field will be restricted to 72 players.
- All entries will be subject to approval by the Tournament Committee who reserve the right to accept or refuse an entry.
- The tournament will be under the management and control of the Alyangula Golf Club Tournament Committee.
- The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews will apply together with such local rules approved by the Tournament Committee.
- The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament. All protests must be made to the Tournament Committee after the conclusion of the days play except on the final day when they must be made to the Tournament Committee within five (5) minutes of the conclusion of play.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter or vary any of the conditions of the Tournament.





CONDITIONS OF ENTRY cont....

- In the event of a tie, the event will be decided by the Australian Count Back System.
- A draw for each days play will be made and displayed on the notice board outside the clubhouse. All endeavors will be made to have the draw available by 8:30 pm of the proceeding days play. Changes or alterations to the draw can only be made by direct contact and approval of the Alyangula Golf Club Tournament Committee or their nominee.
- Handicaps will be adjusted daily; it is the <u>player's responsibility</u> to check the daily handicap changes.
- It is the <u>player's responsibility</u> to ascertain their tee off times. Players shall start at the time and order published by the Match Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "The Player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification". However, it is a condition of this Event that, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the Player arrives at his/her starting point ready to play within five (5) minutes of their starting time, the penalty for failing to start on time will be a two (2) stroke penalty instead of disqualification.

- Practice on the course is not permitted during the 36 hole Event Rule 7-1b applies.
- **Pace of Play**: Rule 6-7 will be enforced. Each group must maintain their position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered to be out of position. Players are requested that if a ball lands in such a position that it would be difficult to locate, that a provisional ball be played immediately to speed up play. Rule 27-1 applies.

Note: Players are only eligible to win one Major Prize
