

Affiliation Fees – Frequently Answered Questions

Q) How much are the 2013-2014 Affiliation fees for Sydney Metropolitan clubs?

Adult	\$41.80pp incl. GST
Junior	\$20.90pp Incl. GST

How much are the 2013-2014 Affiliation fees for Country clubs? Q)

Adult	80% of the Metro fees	\$33.44pp Incl. GST
Junior	80% of the Metro fees	\$16.72pp Incl. GST

Plus: DGA fees

Q) Does the (Country) club have to affiliate with their DGA's and pay the DGA's fees?

Yes - in accordance with Rule 12 of the Golf NSW Constitution, Country golf clubs must affiliate with their District Golf Associations.

Can the club deduct the small club rebate from their affiliation fee payment? Q)

No - Clubs that are fully financial (i.e. affiliation fees paid in full) may apply for the small club rebate. The rebate is a Board initiative to assist small clubs with limited resources. The Board may suspend this program at its discretion.

Q) When are our affiliation fees due?

Affiliation fees are due on 1st July every year.

Q) Can the club pay affiliation fees in instalments?

Clubs may apply for special consideration, in writing, together with a copy of their completed Statutory Declaration. Term payments may be granted at the Board's discretion. Any term payment agreement is subject to the terms & conditions set by the Board and apply only to the year of application. Special consideration might not be granted in subsequent years.

Are Golf Link fees part of the Golf NSW affiliation fees? Q

No. Golf Link is a Golf Australia initiative. Golf Link fees are for use of the handicapping computer system and the club will be billed by Golf Australia, based on the numbers of "active" players the club has on their Golf Link account.
