CONDITIONS – Golf SA Country Junior Amateur Championship

Open to Amateur Golfers who are under 18 years of age on the first day of the event and who have an Australian Handicap for **Boys 18.4 or less** and **Girls 24.4 or less** and who meet Condition 1 below.

- 1. The event is open to male or female amateur golfers who meet the following Country Golfer definition.

 'An Amateur Golfer whose home club (the body which has primary responsibility for ensuring the proper administration of a player's handicap) is a Member Club of a Country District affiliated with Golf SA'.
- 2. The Association reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving explanation. Entries will be restricted to 72 (both boys and girls inclusive).
- 3. It is obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A/USGA approved lists.
- 4. The use of a motorised buggy by a competitor and/or his caddy is prohibited. Motorised means an electric or motor driven vehicle on which a player or caddy may sit or ride whilst the appliance is in motion. Exceptions to this condition may be granted where a player suffers from a permanent disability that would preclude him from competing in the event without the use of a motorized vehicle. Details for such exemptions are available from the office. Penalty Stroke Play 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred maximum penalty per round 4 strokes.
- 5. Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the ASDA for banned substances as laid down in the G.A.'s Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
- 6. Dress Rules: Players and their caddies must comply with the dress requirements of the host club. Non-compliance could see the player not allowed to start or asked to leave the course.
- 7. The Junior and Country Committees of the Golf Association will make all playing arrangements, and will be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged at the clubrooms not later than thirty minutes after the conclusion of play.
- 8. In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Match Committee or Golf SA representative otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined.
- 9. Tee Off Times. **Rule 6-3a** provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of **Rule 6-3a** is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in **Rule33-7**. If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, a penalty for **failure to start on time** of loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes in stroke play will apply.
- 10. A seeded draw for last day will be the order of draw. Groupings will be in three's with the leading players hitting of last. Eg last group leading players 1,2 and 3, second last group 4,5 and 6, etc etc. Girls will use the same seeded draw but the leading players will hit off first.
- 11. The rules governing this event shall be the rules of golf as adopted by the R & A Rules Ltd together with such local rules in play at the host Club. The Golf SA Inc Code of Conduct applies to all competitors.
- 12. **Measuring Devices**, for all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only (this does not include applications for mobile phones).

Conditions - Country Junior Teams Event

- 1. This event is held in conjunction with the Golf SA Country Junior Boys and Girls Championship and Invitational.
- 2. A team consist of four players from one district.
- 3. The teams' event is a gross competition calculated by taken the three lowest scores of the four players each day. Winners will be the district team with the lowest combined gross score of the three lower scores from the four players over the three rounds. In the case of a tie a count back will decide the winner, calculated in the following order last round combined gross score, last nine hole combined gross score, last six holes combined gross score.
- 4. Players are also bound to the conditions 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 set for the "Championship" as above where applicable.
- 5. Prizes Winner team only.

Conditions – Country Junior Boys and Girls Invitational

- 1. This event is held in conjunction with the Golf SA Country Junior Boys and Girls Championship.
- 2. Open to Amateur Golfers who are under 18 years of age on the first day of the event and who have an Australian Handicap for **Boys 18.5 to 32.4. Girls 24.5 to 36.4**
- 3. Players are also bound to the conditions 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 set for the "Championship" as above where applicable.
