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## EVENTS

### EVENT 1 - COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP

**Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September at Royal Adelaide Golf Club - 18 holes**

**Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October at The Grange Golf Club (West Course) - 18 holes**

The Championship will be played over 36 holes stroke play qualifying. The leading 16 players in the qualifying rounds will play off over 18 holes match play on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October at Kooyonga Golf Club & Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October at Kooyonga Golf Club. Winner to have his name inscribed on the Cup & have the right to hold it for 12 months. The handicap limit is 10. In the event of a tie for 16<sup>th</sup> place, this place will be decided by a "sudden death" play off at the conclusion of play on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October, or by countback if time does not permit a play-off. Trophy for Leading Qualifier. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> net each round.

### COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH PLAY

**Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October at Kooyonga Golf Club**

Elimination & Quarter Finals (AM) & (PM) respectively

**Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October at Kooyonga Golf Club**

Semi finals & Final. Trophies for winner & runner-up.

### DISTRICT TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP

Played concurrently with qualifying rounds of Country Championship (Event 1) & President's Cup (Event 2).

Teams consist of six players; four best gross scores each day count. Teams of a minimum of four players will be accepted. Teams will be selected based on lowest handicaps for that district.

Members of the Group Team with the lowest aggregate gross score will receive a trophy & shall be entitled to hold the H.C. McDonald Shield for one year with their names inscribed on the Shield. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by countback.

### COUNTRY CLUB TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP

Played concurrently with qualifying rounds of Country Championship (Event 1) & President's Cup (Event 2).

Teams of four players (one team per club only). Teams will be selected based on lowest handicaps for that club.

Trophies for each member of winning team. The team with the lowest aggregate gross score to hold the Fulwood Trophy for 12 months.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by countback.

### EVENT 2 - PRESIDENT'S CUP

**Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September at Royal Adelaide Golf Club - 18 holes**

**Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October at The Grange Golf Club (West Course) - 18 holes**

The Championship will be played over 36 holes stroke play & is open only to players ineligible for the Country Championship, i.e. with handicaps of 11 & over. Players will be drawn to follow Event 1.

Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> gross in President's Cup. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> net each round.

### EVENT 3 - COUNTRY FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

**Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October at Adelaide Shores Golf Club**

The Championship will be played over 18 holes

Players enter in pairs. The aggregate handicap limit is 18. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place

A handicap event will be played in conjunction. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Gross 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place cannot win net prizes

### EVENT 4 - VICE PRESIDENT'S SALVER (FOURSOMES)

**Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October at Adelaide Shores Golf Club**

Stroke event will be played over 18 holes

Players enter in pairs. The aggregate handicap limit is 19 & over. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Will be drawn to follow event 3.

A handicap event will be played in conjunction. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Gross 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place cannot win net prizes

### EVENT 5 - INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

**Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October at Glenelg Golf Club - 18 holes**

18 holes Stableford in A & B grades. A grade 0-12 & B grade 13-27.

Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> in each grade.

### EVENT 6 - FOUR-BALL BETTER BALL STABLEFORD

**Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October at Kooyonga Golf Club**

18 holes. Players enter in pairs. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>. For ALL players with individual handicaps of 0-27. Limit 50 pairs.

In the event of more than 50 pairs, the remainder will be balloted out based on date entry received.

## CONDITIONS

### 1. Format

- 1.1 Refer to Events 1 – 6.
- 1.2 All ties in handicap events will be decided by countback.

### 2. Handicaps

- 2.1 A player's handicap on the first day of Events 1 - 5 determines entered event. If a player's handicap has changed since entry which moves him into a different event, the draw will not change, but the player will compete in the event that reflects his current handicap.
- 2.2 In the handicap events, a player entering on the handicap limit of 27 who exceeds that handicap before the first day of play may remain in the event playing on the handicap limit.

### 3. Match Committee

- 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise the Golf SA Match Committee.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
- 3.6 The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, alter the venue, time or day of play.

### 4. Rules of Play

- 4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

### 5. Entries

- 5.1 Eligible players for the event are: male amateur golfers whose home club (the body which has primary responsibility for ensuring the proper administration of a player's handicap) is a Member Club of a Country District affiliated with Golf SA.
- 5.2 Entries must be made via the Golf SA online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 5.3 Entry fee must be paid at time of entry.
- 5.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 5.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 5.6 Players must register by **5.00pm on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2013**. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the **Registered Participants** section of the relevant event registration page.
- 5.7 **Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries.**

### 6. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting

- 6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting.

### 7. Drug Testing

- 7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

### 8. Mobile Phones

- 8.1 Mobile phones must be switched off when on the golf course and may only be used in an emergency.

### 9. Smoking

- 9.1 Players are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf SA's Code of Conduct.

### 10. Pace of Play

- 10.1 Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered to be out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

### 11. Motorised Transport

- 11.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted except for events 1, 2, 3, 4. For these events Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Application and approvals to be forwarded to Golf SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

### 12. Code of Conduct

- 12.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf SA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at [www.golfsa.com.au](http://www.golfsa.com.au).

### 13. Measuring Devices

- 13.1 For all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only (this does not include applications for mobile phones).

### 14. Draws

- 14.1 Competitors will be drawn in such manner as the Match Committee shall arrange. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter the draw without notice.
- 14.2 Tee times will be available on the Golf SA website [www.golfsa.com.au](http://www.golfsa.com.au) from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2013.
