CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. Open to male amateurs aged 55 years or older on 16 September 2013.
- 2. Players entering the Super Seniors event must be aged 65 years or older.
- 3. The entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone without payment.
- 4. The Kooyonga Golf Club reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving an explanation. Any entrant may withdraw and have their entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the date entries close.
- 5. The field will be strictly limited. In the event of entries exceeding this limit, a handicap ballot will apply.
- 6. The draw will be published by 10 September 2013 and sent by email to all participants. It will also be on The Kooyonga Golf Club website.
- 7. The Rules governing this event shall be the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules enforced by the Kooyonga Golf Club Inc.
- 8. Competitors must start at the appointed time. Rule 6-3 will apply.
- 9. The Match Committee of The Kooyonga Golf Club will make playing arrangements and be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play. In the event of a tie the Golf Australia Count Back guidelines will be applied.
- 10. Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be applied to players in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to imposition of penalties.
- 11. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
- 12. Golf Australia conditions in relation to Drug Testing and Code of Conduct apply.
- 13. Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of The Kooyonga Golf Club.
- 13. A presentation will be held immediately after the results are posted.
