The 2013 program for our Rules Seminars and Exams now has the majority completed and the online exam format is proving very popular and successful.

He has provided his overall expertise from the computer industry and programming background to drive the development and implementation of this national project. This online system will be used Nationally. Thanks also must go to a considerable number of people who have assisted with the drafting, review and editing of the pool of questions. It is a time consuming process that can only be done by personnel with considerable rules knowledge and experience.

State Level Rules Accreditation

By invitation, persons who have achieved an appropriate pass mark in club level, are invited to express interest in participating in the State Level Accreditation process. This year we have our maximum number of 24 attending the 2013 State Level seminar and exam to be conducted at Elanora Country Club on the weekend 7th & 8th September.

Captains & Committee Seminars

These are conducted for captains and committee members to assist in efficient and effective running of competitions – included are subject matters such as, resolution of disputes, drafting conditions and local rules for events, how to handle weather disruptions, delays and much more. Attendees have shown great appreciation in their feedback.

Most recent sessions have been conducted at Wagga and ACT. Next will be 9th September at Bermagui for Far South Coast and 10th September for Illawarra (venue to be confirmed). We are on schedule to have covered all regional and metropolitan areas in NSW by mid 2014.

High Performance Manager Khan Pullen recently returned from overseas and provided an update on our NSW players. Callan O'Reilly was the only NSW player to compete in the Porter Cup. Cathleen Santoso and Carly Beck both competed in the Women's Canadian Amateur. Cathleen was tied 31st with Jayde Panos for best placed Australian. In the Western Amateur, Brett Drewitt finished best placed Australian T27. Jordan Zunic, Ruben Sondjaja, and Ricky Kato also competed but missed the 36 hole cut. For the last major event of the US summer, the Men's US Amateur is currently being contested. Brett Drewitt, Jordan Zunic and Will Flitcroft were the three NSW players to qualify. Unfortunately, Jordan sustained injuries in a car accident and had to withdraw. Both Brett and Will missed qualifying in the match play. New Website and Logo for WGCNC


