CONDITIONS

- 1. Format**
 - 1.1 The event will be played over 18 holes of stroke play
 - 1.2 In the event of a tie in Silver or Bronze, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other placegetters will be decided by countback.
- 2. Handicaps**
 - 2.1 A player entering Silver Division who exceeds the handicap limit of 18 before the first day of play must transfer to Bronze Division. A player entering Bronze Division who reduces below the handicap limit of 19 before the first day of play must transfer to Silver Division.
- 3. Match Committee**
 - 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise the Golf SA Match Committee.
 - 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
 - 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
 - 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
 - 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
 - 3.6 The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, alter the venue, time or day of play.
- 4. Rules of Play**
 - 4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.
- 5. Entries**
 - 5.1 Open to any female amateur golfer who is a member of a club affiliated with Golf SA or State or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, who works a minimum of 20 hours per week or who is a full-time tertiary student.
 - 5.2 Registrations on MiTournament must include the name of business, employer or tertiary institution.
 - 5.3 Eligible players for the Silver event are: female amateurs whose Australian Handicap or overseas equivalent does not exceed 18 and in the Bronze event whose Australian Handicap is within the range 19-45.
 - 5.4 The Entrance Fee for the Championship is \$30.00 (including GST).
 - 5.5 Entries must be made via the Golf SA online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted
- 5.6** The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 5.7** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 5.8** Players must register by 5.00pm on Monday 30th September 2013. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the **Registered Participants** section of the event registration page.
- 5.9** Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries.
- 6. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting**
 - 6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting.
- 7. Drug Testing**
 - 7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.
- 8. Smoking**
 - 8.1 Players are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf SA's Code of Conduct.
- 9. Mobile Phones**
 - 9.1 Mobile phones must be switched off when on the golf course and may only be used in an emergency.
- 10. Pace of Play**
 - 10.1 Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered to be out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- 11. Motorised Transport**
 - 11.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Application and approvals to be forwarded with entry form. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.
- 12. Code of Conduct**
 - 12.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf SA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golfsa.com.au.
- 13. Measuring Devices**
 - 12.1 For all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only.
- 14. Draws**
 - 14.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf SA website www.golfsa.com.au from Monday 7th October 2013.
