35th SUNSHINE COAST LADIES OPEN AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP & CLASSIC

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

FLIGIBILITY

- 1. THE CHAMPIONSHIP will be played at Headland Golf Club over 54 Holes of Stroke Play on Friday 15th, Saturday 16th & Sunday 17th November 2013. This Australian Ranking and Golf Queensland ranking event is open to women golfers who possess a G.A. handicap (or international equivalent) with a Handicap Limit of 9 or less on the first day of play. (see Note 11 below)
- 2. THE CLASSIC will be played concurrently at Headland Golf Club over 36 Holes of Stroke Play on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th November in divisions to be decided at close of entry. These events are open to all women golfers who possess a GA handicap (or international equivalent) with Handicap Limit of 36 or less on the first day of play. (see Note 12 below)
- 3. The JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP (Golf Queensland ranking event for those aged less than 18 years,) MID CHAMPIONSHIP (age 30-54) and SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP (QSOOM ranking event for 55 years +) events will be conducted concurrently using only the 2 day 36 Hole Classic scores (Saturday / Sunday). Age is as at the first day of play.

FNTRIFS

- 4. Enter online at www.mitournament.com
- 5. Entries close at 3pm on Friday 1st November. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Committee.
- 6. All entries will be displayed on the Mi Tournament website as they are received. Inquiries can be through the Headland Golf Club administration office on (07) 5444 5800 ext. #3.
- 7. Nomination Fees of \$65 (54 Hole Championship) or \$45 (36 Hole Classic) must accompany entries.
- 8. Players who withdraw prior to the draw being published will be refunded their entry fee, less an administration fee of \$10.00.

HANDICAPS

- 9. Entries without a Golf Link number must be accompanied by a handicap record endorsed by an official of the player's home club.
- 10. Handicap increases or decreases after the closing date for entries may affect your relevant division, and your time of play. Please advise Headland Golf Club if your handicap changes.
- 11. For the Open Championship: If a player enters this event on a handicap of 9 or less, but by the first day of play has increased to 10 or more, they will be entitled to a part refund of entry fee, or may play a practice round on the Friday, and then participate in the appropriate Division for the Classic 2 day event.
- 12. For the Classic Events: Players who enter on Handicap of 36 or less, and subsequently increase their handicap are still welcome to participate but must play off the Tournament Handicap Limit of 36.
- 13. Handicaps are retained for all Aggregate Net Trophies, but any handicap reduction in the 1st round applies to daily net score of subsequent rounds.

PLAY

- 14. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE: A Championship Committee, appointed by Headland Golf Club, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times or draws, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another date/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decisions of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any such decision shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
- 15. THE RULES OF GOLF as adopted by the R & A will apply, together with the Golf Australia Hard Card Conditions of Competition and Local Rules, and supplementary local rules as agreed by the Championship Committee.
- 16. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. Gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification.
- 17. CADDIES: Players may engage professional golfers as caddies.
- 18. CONFORMING Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting: The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting.
- 19. PACE OF PLAY: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to players in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- 20. TIES: for the Open Championship will be decided by a sudden death playoff of the 18th Hole to decide the winner. In the event of ties arising between more than two players the same method of elimination shall apply until a result is achieved. Ties in all other events will be decided by G.A. count-back system.
- 21. SEEDING: The Championship field will be seeded for Round 3 in gross order of first cards posted.
- 22. PROTESTS: Protests must be submitted in writing at the Scorer's Table no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round on each day.

GENERAL

- 23. TROPHIES: Only one trophy per competitor.
- 24. PUBLICITY: Headland Golf Club arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Championship, and by entering all players assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).
- 25. PRIVACY: Headland Golf Club may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, handicap) of entrants in this Championship to advise you of future golf events at Headland. This information will not be available to any other organization and your details can be removed by phoning Headland Golf Club on 5444 5800.
- 26. MOTORISED TRANSPORT: is permitted for all net events. For Gross events, a copy of medical/exemption certificate must accompany entry.
- 27. MOBILE PHONES: The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during the play of any competition round is prohibited. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disgualification (RULE 33-7).
- 28. DRUG TESTING: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia's Doping Policy endorsed by Golf Queensland. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
