Conditions of Entry:

- 1. Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry. Please note that fees are not transferable
- 2. Entries are to be made payable to Mount Gambier Golf Club Inc, Po Box 1027 Mount Gambier SA 5290
- 3. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, together with such local rules as are in force on the links over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in Charge of the competition whose decision shall be final.
- 4. The Committee has the power to temporarily alter a players Australian Handicap in accordance with the Australian Course Rating and Handicap System.
- 5. In every event competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Committee may arrange, and the Committee, or such person as the Committee may authorise, shall have the power to select a partner for any competitor whose partner is not present when called upon at the appointed start.
- 6. The Committee will make arrangements and have full power to alter or make any variations in the conditions should they deem it desirable.
- 7. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reasons, either shorten a contest or fix another day.
- 8. In the event of ties, the winner shall be deemed as under:
- 36 Hole Championships—by play off on the final day sudden death, the players are to play holes 1,9,10,18, hole by hole until a decision is reached.
- 18 Hole Scratch and Handicap Events—by count back in the manner recommended by Australian Golf. The best score of the last 9 holes shall be used.
- In Handicap events—the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied.
- The Committee reserves the right to dispense with count back procedures and present trophies n lieu circumstances where it is considered appropriate.
- Ambrose events will have a minimum handicap of 1
- 9. The committee shall have the power to cancel any event or to limit the numbers of entries, which may be received in different events, and to alter the time fixed for starting an event, as indicated in the program.




