



Year 8/9 Golf Championship Thursday 28th and Friday 29th November

North Adelaide Golf Course - Strangways Terrace, North Adelaide

There has traditionally been a strong SAPSASA participation event supporting students in years 5, 6 and 7 and the introduction of this Championship in 2011 ensures a continuous pathway for Students into their early secondary school years. This event is supported by Golf SA

The Event is a stroke competition with the sole aim of creating participation.

Day 1 - Thursday 28th November 2013

- 18 Holes Multi Tee Start, North Adelaide Golf Complex (North Course).
- Start Time 8.30am. Draw will be displayed on the Golf SA and SSSSA website 7 days prior. (Draw format may vary depending on the number of entries.)
- The field will be made up of both Metropolitan and Country Students who have entered the event by submitting an entry form.
- Metro students will compete for the Metro Championship.
- Country students will compete for the Country Championship.

Day 2 - Friday 29th November

State Championship

- 18 hole SSSSA Yr 8/9 State Championship North Adelaide South Course
- Field will include a maximum of the best 48 Boys and 16 Girls scores from Day 1
- 1st tee start from 8.45am.
- An awards ceremony will be held at the completion of play.

Golf SA- SSSSA Yr 8/9 Invitational – Friday 29th November

- For those players that missed the cut on Day 1 for the State Championship
- 18 holes North Adelaide Golf Complex (North Course)
- Multi tee start from 8.30am
- An awards ceremony will be held at the completion of play.

It is expected that all players will have their own equipment and a little knowledge of golf which may have been gained through a school golf program.

Year 8/9 SSSSA

Golf Championship Tournament Conditions

Eligibility:

The championship is open to both male and female Secondary School Students in Years 8 or 9, with OR without handicaps who are enrolled and attending a school affiliated with SSSSA.

Rules:

Players are expected to have some golf experience and have some understanding of golf etiquette. Information on Golf Etiquette can be obtained from the Golf Australia website.

Entry:

All players must submit an individual entry form before the due date.

Championship Format:

The Championships is a 2 day event.

- Day 1- The Metropolitan and Country Championships will be held on the same day which will be known as the Golf SA – SSSSA Metro & Country Championship with tee times to be posted on SSSSA & Golf SA websites two weeks prior to the event. This event will be played on the North Adelaide North Course.
- **Day 2** A State Championship will be held on Day 2. The top 64 golfers from the Metro and Country Championships will play in the State Championships with a maximum of 48 boys and a minimum of 16 girls. All players are required to report at 8.00am and to check the seeded draw for hit off times. This event will be played on the North Adelaide South Course.
- **Day 2** Golf SA- SSSSA Invitational event is for those players who miss the cut for the State Championship this event will take place at the same time as the state championship but on North Adelaide's North Course.

All players must report at 8.00am.

Note: Final hit-off format will be designed to reflect the number of entries and won't be known until entries have closed.

Medals & Trophies:

SSSSA- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in both the Metro & Country Championships. (Day1). If there is a tie for places each player will be awarded a medal.

Golf SA trophies will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the State Championships (Day 2). In the event of a tie for first place a play off will decide the winner. The Count back system will be used in the event of ties for remaining places.

Golf SA will also provide trophies for the Golf SA – SSSSA Invitational on Day 2. The Count back system will be used in the event of ties.

Supervisors:

Parents or Teachers may be asked to assist as walkers/supervisors for a group but are not to act as a caddie or coach.

Inclement Weather:

Golf SA & SSSSA weather policies are to apply, in the case of adverse conditions the playing format may be modified or cancelled.



Golf SA - Tournament Conditions - Championships

- 1. Entries for the event close with Golf SA PO Box 423 North Adelaide 5006 no later than 5pm on Monday 18th of November 2013. No entries by telephone will be accepted, but the Association reserves the right to accept entries after the closing time in special circumstances.
 - 1.1 Entrance Fee must be paid by or on day one of the event.
- 2. It is obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A/USGA approved lists.
- 3. The use of a motorised buggy by a competitor and/or his caddy is prohibited. Motorised means electric or motor driven vehicle on which a player or caddy may sit or ride whilst the appliance is in motion. Exceptions to this condition may be granted where a player suffers from a permanent disability that would preclude him from competing in the event without the use of a motorized vehicle. Details for such exemptions are available from the office. Penalty Stroke Play 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred maximum penalty per round 4 strokes.
- 4. Dress Rules: Players and their caddies must comply with the dress requirements of the host clubs. Non-compliance could see the player not allowed to start or asked to leave the course. (No track suits or sport shorts, shirts must have a collar.)
- 5. Golf SA will make all playing arrangements, and will be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged at the clubrooms not later than thirty minutes after the conclusion of play.
- 6. Results and prize allocation are subject to player handicap scrutiny. This may take place post event and in the result of a discrepancy results and prize allocation will be adjusted.
- 6. In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Match Committee or Golf SA representative otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined.
- 7. Tee Off Times. **Rule 6-3a** provides: "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of **Rule 6-3a** is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in **Rule33-7.** If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, a penalty for **failure to start on time** of loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes in stroke play will apply.
- 8. The rules governing this event shall be the rules of golf as adopted by the R & A Rules Ltd together with such local rules in play at the host Club. The Golf SA Inc Code of Conduct applies to all competitors.
- 9. Golf SA will retain all score cards for 7 days after the event.
- 10. Golf SA will handicap cards where a player has an official handicap.
