2013 Men's 'C' Grade Amateur Championship of Tasmania **Championship Conditions**

Eliaibility

All events shall be open only to amateurs, full playing or junior members of any recognised golf club affiliated with a State Association whose Australian men's handicap is no less than 19.5 and does not exceed 36.4 at the time of entry.

Championship Procedures

- The Championship shall be played over 36-holes of stroke-play, 18-holes
- on Saturday 23 and 18-holes on Sunday 24 November, 2013. Golf Tasmania medallions will be awarded to the Championship Winner and Handicap Winner. All other prizes are subject to the number of entries received in each event justifying such prizes.

Championship Committee

- All events shall be under the entire control of the SGC which shall have full power to alter or make any variations to the conditions, or alter the time fixed for starting any event as indicated in the programme.
- The SGC reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason for so doing.
- The SGC may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, cancel or fix another day for this tournament or any part thereof.

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply together with such local rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.

- Entrance Fee must be paid at time of entry.
- Entries must be made on the attached entry form and must be countersigned by the Secretary or Club Official of the entrant's Club.
- Entries must be made with the Secretary, Scottsdale Golf Club, PO Box 52, Scottsdale, 7260 not later than 5.00pm on Friday 8 November, 2013. (a) All official Australian handicaps will be fixed by the Handicapping
- Committee of the SGC. The Handicapping Committee reserves the right to make any alteration in the handicap of any entrant before he starts in each event should it be deemed desirable.
 - (b) All handicaps shall be taken and fixed as per the date of entry and will remain for the entirety of the event.
- Ties shall be decided as follows:- Ties for winners in scratch events shall be decided on the same day, hole by hole, until a decision is reached. Ties in handicap events and for runners-up in all stroke events shall be decided by count back.
- Should entries exceed 90, the higher handicapped players will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded. All reference for handicap to be taken as at time of entry.
- Competitors are required to observe the dress regulations of the Host Club at all times
- Competitors will be made Honorary Members, without fee, of the Host Club from 22-24 November.
- The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls and Time of Starting.

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain it's position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Driving Clubs

Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Limited.

Exception: A driver with a clubhead that was manufactured prior to 1999 is exempt from this condition. (The list may be viewed at www.golftasmania.org.au)
* PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH,

CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION:

Stroke-play - Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round - Four strokes.

- * Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to their marker or fellow competitor immediately upon discovery a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, they are disqualified.
- PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.

Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. Clarification of any medication can be obtained via the ASADA hotline - 1800 020 506, or from www.asada.gov.au

No Smoking

All competitors and caddies are subject to State Government laws prohibiting the smoking of cigarettes, cigars or the like during the course of any round played in a competition

Motorised Transport

During play, it is prohibited for a player or their caddy to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless permitted by a member of the Championship

Stroke-play – Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes.

Note: Permission will only be granted to entrants who, for medical reasons, normally use a vehicle at their home club. Attach home club endorsement to this effect to a written application.

GPS Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au
