



HISTORY AND HONOUR ROLL – Australian Men’s and Women’s Mid Amateur Championships

History

The first Australian Mid Amateur Championships were played in 2007, over 54-holes stroke play. The Men’s Championship was a stand-alone Championship, however for the first three years, the Women’s Championship was played in conjunction with the Australian Women’s Senior Amateur Championship.

In 2010, the Men’s and Women’s Mid Amateur Championships were combined. Both events are for players aged 30 – 54 years.

For the first three years, the winner of the Men’s Mid Amateur received an exemption into the Australian Open.
