- NSW teams won the Walking Stick and Teams event at Aust Seniors.
- Dominated Australian team selections, with the following representing – Stefan, Denis, David, Ross, Richard, Sal, Greg S, Greg Mc, Vince, Robert, Steve.
- Stefan again takes out the Aust SOOM, and NSW players fill 7 of the top 10 positions.
- National events were won by Bill Banks (2), Stefan Albinski (2), Roy Vandersluis,
- An unbelievable tie in the NSW SOOM with Ross and Denis both on 2200points. Denis took out the over 65 section.
- Chris Collins again took out the Iron Man award, but this year not a 100% attendance... a bit disappointing, but not his fault!!!

2014 NSW Men's SOOM:

The schedule for next year has been finalised and again we have an extensive program. See attached schedule. Four new events have been added – Wyong, Pt Kembla, Shelly Beach and Kooindah Waters re appears. Our NSW Championship (4 – 6 March) at Tuncurry GC - Les has just returned from there and reports the Club is right behind the event and the course is in terrific condition. After a successful 2013 there are only minor changes for next year;

- All events will have 150 points for the winner, except NSW Senior Championship will be 450 points and ACT Seniors 400points.
- Best of 14 scores will remain.
- The 54 hole NSW Senior Classic will have 150 points (in addition to the 150 points for each round.. The Lakes, The Australian, Avondale).
- Our end of year presentation luncheon has been scheduled a week later so as not to conflict with Asian Seniors and Senior Golf Society. Also Long Reef will have a PM shotgun and Cromer an AM shotgun with an overall 36 hole 150 point event. Hopefully more of the non- Metro guys can attend.
- The over 65 SOOM qualification will be that the player must have turned 65 by the first day of the NSW Senior Championship.
- We are looking to include a 'most improved' as well as continuing the Iron Man trophy.
