

Conditions of entry

1. Open to Amateur Players whose Australian handicap does not exceed 7 for male competitors, 10 for junior competitors and 14 for lady competitors.
2. **Entry fee of \$35.00 (per player – includes lunch and GST).**
3. **Entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise entry cannot be accepted.**
4. No refund of entrance fee unless notification for withdrawal is received before Tuesday 18 February 2014.
5. No pay on the day entries will be accepted.
6. Entries must reach The Stirling Golf Club by 5pm Friday 14 February 2014. Starting times will be available from the Pro Shop on Friday 21st February; Telephone: 8339 1805 or the Club's website <http://www.stirlinggolf.com.au/>.
7. The Stirling Golf Club reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving an explanation or limit the number of entries accepted.
8. **NOTE:** The Golf SA Code of Conduct applies to this event, including the use of mobile phones and alcohol consumption.
9. Competitors and Caddies must observe Club Dress Rules.
10. Conditions of Play will be posted on the Notice Board on the day of the event.
11. The event will be conducted and controlled by the Match Committee of The Stirling Golf Club who will umpire in the case of any dispute. Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Manager before 6:00pm on the day of play.
12. In the event of a tie, the Match Committee will determine the manner of play-off. Competitors will only be eligible for one trophy on the day. Trophies will be awarded to Gross Championship (senior, junior and ladies) and for handicap.
13. Wearing of soft spikes is mandatory.
14. Use of motorised golf buggies is not permitted unless the user possesses a medical certificate.
15. The rules governing this event shall be the rules as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are enforced by The Stirling Golf Club & the rules of the SAGA
16. Competitors will be made Honorary Members of The Stirling Golf Club on the day of the competition.
17. Heat Policy: In the interest of player safety it is recommended that players exercise caution during extreme temperature conditions. However the Club has a policy, which states that if the forecast temperature for the day as advised by the Bureau of Meteorology at 9am, is 40 degrees or higher the event at the discretion of the Match Committee maybe either abandoned or reduced to 18 holes.
18. Practice Round only on Friday 21st February at a Green Fee of \$30. Bookings essential.
