2014 Lindisfarne Cup Golf Tournament Championship Conditions

1. The Championship

- 1.1 The Lindisfarne Cup Golf Tournament will be played over 36 holes. 18 holes on Saturday 1 February and 18 holes on Sunday 2 February 2014.
- 1.2 The event is open to male golfers, either amateur or professional. Amateur players must have a current Golf Australia handicap of 18.4 or less which has been certified by his home Club Secretary. Professional players must be members of the Professional Golfers' Association.

2. Rules

- 2.1 Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.
- 2.2 The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made in writing to the Championship Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
- 2.3 The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event and to refuse any entry without explanation.

3. Competitors

The field will be limited to 80 players. In the event of applications exceeding the number of places available, entries for higher handicap competitors will be decided by handicap ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance Fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete. All references to handicap to be taken as at time of entry.

4. Handicaps

- 4.1 All handicaps will be fixed by the Championship Committee of Tasmania Golf Club. The Committee reserves the right to make any alteration in the handicap of any entrant before he starts in each event should it deem desirable.
- 4.2 It is the duty of each competitor to report any reduction in his handicap to the starter prior to hitting off.
- 4.3 The player's handicap at the commencement of the first round will remain for the entirety of the event.

5. Ties

- 5.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined.
- 5.2 Ties in handicap events will be decided by countback in accordance with the system approved by Golf Tasmania.

6. Entries

- 6.1 All entrants must stipulate their date of birth on the entry form.
- 6.2 Entries must be made on the attached form and must be accompanied by the entry fee. They must be in the hands of the Executive Officer, Tasmania Golf Club, PO Box 425, SORELL, 7172 no later than 5.00pm on Sunday, 26th January 2014.

Conforming Golf Balls, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting.

8. Trophies

8.1 The winner shall be the Lindisfarne Cup Champion for 2014.

- 8.2 Players who are aged under 18 years at the last day of the competition are eligible for the Junior Event.
- 8.3 Players who are aged 18 years to 23 years inclusive as at the last day of the competition are eligible for the Colts Event.
- 8.4 Players who are aged 55 years and over at the last day of the competition are eligible for the Senior Event.

9. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties at the sole discretion of the Committee.

10. Membership Privileges

10.1 All competitors will be made honorary members, without fee, courtesy of the Host Club, on the respective days of play.

11. Motorised Transport

During play, it is prohibited for a player or their caddy to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless permitted by a member of the Championship Committee.

Stroke-play – Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes.

Note: Permission will only be granted to entrants who, for medical reasons, normally use a vehicle at their home club. Attach home club endorsement to this effect to a written application.

12. Driving Clubs

Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Limited.

Exception: A driver with a clubhead that was manufactured prior to 1999 is exempt from this condition. (The list may be viewed at www.golftasmania.org.au)

* PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION:

 $Stroke-play-Two\ strokes\ for\ each\ hole\ at\ which\ a\ breach\ occurred;\\ maximum\ penalty\ per\ round-Four\ strokes.$

- * Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to their marker or fellow competitor immediately upon discovery a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, they are disqualified.
- * PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.

13. Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. Clarification of any medication can be obtained via the ASADA hotline – 1800 020 506, or from www.asada.gov.au

- 14.1 If a competitor fails to report for any round, fails to meet all his playing obligations and fails to submit a satisfactory reason to the Championship Committee, future entries may be refused for tournaments under the auspices of Golf Tasmania.
- 14.2 In the event of a player failing to hand in a card and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the Championship Committee, he will be disqualified from all events in the Championship.

15. GPS Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

16. Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au. In addition, all members agree to be bound by the standards of conduct expected of members of Tasmania Golf Club and, in the event those standards are breached, acknowledge that they will be subject to sanctions imposed by the Championship Committee.

EVENT NO. 1 - 2014 LINDISFARNE CUP GOLF TOURNAMENT

36 Holes Stroke Play.

EVENT NO. 2 - JUNIOR 36 HOLE SCRATCH

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are aged under 18 years as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

EVENT NO. 3 - COLTS 36 HOLE SCRATCH

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are aged 18 years to 23 years inclusive as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

EVENT NO. 4 - SENIOR 36 HOLE SCRATCH

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are 55 years of age and over, as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

EVENT NO. 5 - JUNIOR 36 HOLE NETT

EVENT NO. 6- COLTS 36 HOLE NETT

EVENT NO. 7 - SENIOR 36 HOLE NETT

NOTE: Eligibility for events 5, 6 and 7 as per relevant 'scratch' events.

Junior, Colts and Senior events must have a minimum of five (5) players in each.
