NSW PAR 3 CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

The GolfNSW Standard Conditions and the GolfNSW Code of Conduct apply to this Championship where indicated. Where there is any inconsistency between the conditions set out in the GolfNSW Standard Conditions and those set out for this Championship, the conditions for this Championship will prevail.

A copy of the GolfNSW Standard Conditions and GolfNSW Code of Conduct is available from the GolfNSW website at www.golfnsw.com.au and will be displayed at the Host Club(s) and will be available on request.

A: CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

1. The Championship Committee shall comprise of the Team Leader of Sefton Golf Course, Duty Manager of Sefton Golf Course and a Sefton Golf Club representative.
2. All entries are subject to the approval of the Championship Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision which will be final.
3. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship shall be final.
4. The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend these Conditions.

B: GENERAL

1. The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the GolfNSW Standard Conditions for State Events and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.
2. The Championship will be stroke play over one round of 18 holes at Sefton Golf Course .
3. In the event of a tie for the Championship, players in such a tie will continue over such holes as the Championship Committee will decide in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole play-off until the winner is determined. If insufficient time is available for a play-off, joint winners will be declared. All other ties will be determined using the Golf Australia countback system.
4. *Use of Motorised Transport:* The use of motorised carts, excluding Players competing in the Seniors division, will not be permitted. Battery operated buggies are permitted for use in all divisions. The Transportation Policy condition as outlined in the GolfNSW Standard Conditions applies to this Championship.
5. *Pace of Play:* Pace of play policy guidelines **will be laid down and strictly enforced** (see note 2; Rule 6-7). Penalties will be issued to individuals in groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to the application of penalties. **A copy of the pace of play conditions will be posted at the Championship venue and will be available on request.**
6. *Mobile Phone:* The Mobile Phone condition as outlined in the NSWGA Standard Conditions for State Events applies to this Championship .
7. *Distance Measuring Devices:* refer to conditions of play.
8. *Consumption of Alcohol:* The Consumption of Alcohol condition as outlined in the GolfNSW Standard Conditions applies to this Championship.
9. *NSW Code of Conduct:* The GolfNSW Code of Conduct applies to all players participating in this Championship.
10. Entrants shall comply with the by-laws, rules and dress regulations of the Host Club. Players not complying with such regulations will not be permitted to start their round.

C: ENTRIES

1. The Championship is open to male and female amateurs whose handicap does not exceed 36.4 strokes (men) or 45.4 strokes (women and juniors) at the date of entry. The GA Slope for Sefton Golf Course will be applied to all players handicaps on the day of play.
2. The entry fee is \$35 (including GST) and must be received prior to the players tee time.
3. Entries must be made on the attached Entry Form or a facsimile copy thereof. Entries will not be accepted by telephone, email or facsimile (Exception - facsimile entries with credit card payment details).
4. The Entry Form (by post or by facsimile with credit card details) and relevant entry fee must be received at Sefton Golf Course Pro Shop (160 Rose St Sefton NSW 2162) prior to 4pm Friday 7 March 2010.
5. All entries must include the entrant's current handicap and provide their Golfink number on the entry form.
6. All entrants must have competed and completed 8 competitions rounds in the 3 months prior to the Championships (ie from 22nd December 2013) so that an accurate playing handicap is applied.
7. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Ltd, the NSW Golf Association's Code of Conduct and shall sign a declaration to that effect contained on the Entry Form or agree to such conditions through the online entry process.

8. In the event of an entrant being suspended by an affiliated club, a club affiliated with a District Golf Association, a District Golf Association on a golf related matter the entrant shall not be eligible to enter the Championship, even if he nominates another club as his home club for handicap purposes.
9. In the event of entrants exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, entries from those higher handicap competitors shall be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful entrants shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not subsequently compete.
10. Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal prior to the closing date for entries or after the close of entries for medical reasons (a medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds). All refunds will be subject to a \$10.00 administration fee (includes GST).
11. Late entries may be accepted after the closing date at the discretion of the Match Committee. Any such entry shall be subject to \$5.00 late fee (includes GST).

D: REGISTRATION

1. Competitors must register 30 minutes prior to their allotted tee time at the Sefton Golf Course Professional Shop.

E: PRACTICE

1. Practice rounds prior to the Championship are at the discretion of Sefton Golf Course. Permission must be sought from the host and practice times may be booked directly with the Professional Shop.

F: PRIZES

1. Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order:

 - Par 3 Championship First place Scratch Senior (over 55 years as at 22 March, Male)
 - Second Place Senior scratch (Male)
 - First Place Senior Net (Male)

 - Par 3 Championship First place Scratch Junior (under 17 years as at 21 March, Female)
 - Second Place Junior scratch (Female)
 - First Place Junior Net (Female)

 - Par 3 Championship First place Scratch Junior (under 17 years as at 21 March, Male)
 - Second Place Junior scratch (Male)
 - First Place Junior Net (Male)

G: DATABASE OF ENTRANT'S DETAILS
