

Mt Barker-Handorf Golf Club 27 Hole Amateur Open Tournament

- 1. Maximum handicap, Men 27 & Women 36
- 2. Golfers must have a valid AGU handicap at the time of entry
- 3. Players can only win one major trophy on the day. 27 Hole event will take precedence
- 4. In the event of a tie for the Gross Open Event the winner shall be decided by the way of a playoff. If daylight calls a halt to play then joint winners will be announced
- 5. All ties in all other events (Excluding Gross Open 27 Hole) the winner will be decided on a countback basis
- **6.** If the number of entries exceed the size of the field then precedence will be given on a received basis. First in first served
- 7. The Match Committee has the sole right to change the basis of the event in all or any part and their decision shall be final
- 8. Tee times will be posted on our website www.mtbarkergolf.com.au as from Thursday 27th March 2013
- 9. It is the competitors responsibility to confirm their tee times
