PLAYER INFORMATION

Registration

Registration must be done on each day prior to commencing play. Ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register.

Transportation

Manildra GC will be offering a bus service on Saturday and Sunday to and from the Club. The bus will depart Orange at 5:30am and 11:00am both mornings, via Molong.

Collection of Shirts

If you purchased a Player Shirt, please collect on the first day of play from the registration desk.

Scorecard return and scoring

On completion of your round, ensure you return your scorecard to the designated 'scorecard return area' in the clubhouse. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Prizes

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course during the day. Please utilise them if you need to.

Dress Regulations

All entrants must comply with the Golf NSW Dress Regulations. Jeans will not be permitted.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring devices may be used.

Motorised Carts

As per the conditions of entry, participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Match Committee. Applications for permission must be made at the time of entry, and copies of medical certificates submitted to Golf NSW prior to the event. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

Player Responsibilities

All Players must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
