PLAYER INFORMATION

FORMAT

SINGLES EVENTS

The singles event will be played in three divisions. The divisions are based on exact GA handicaps at close of entries. Players will play off their daily handicap as calculated on the day of the event. The divisions listed below are solely for the purpose of formulating the draw. Please see the draw to ensure you are aware of your correct division allocation. At close of entries the divisions were set as below:

- Division 1 – GA Handicap of plus - 19
- Division 2 – GA Handicap of 19.1 – 25.3
- Division 3 – GA Handicap of 25.4 – 45.4

On the day of play, those whose GA Handicap is higher than the maximum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, but will use the maximum handicap applicable. Those whose GA Handicap is lower than the minimum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, and will use their current daily (playing) handicap for nett prizes.

FOURSOMES

Wednesday 5 March

The foursomes event will be played in two divisions. The divisions are based on exact GA handicaps at close of entries. Please see the draw to ensure you are aware of your correct division allocation. Pairings play off half the combined total of their daily handicaps. At close of entries the divisions were set as below:

- Highlands Golf Club - Division 1 - stroke - (half combined) GA Handicap of plus – 22.8
- Bowral Golf Club - Division 2 - stroke – (half combined) GA Handicap of 22.9 – 44.5

As for the singles event, on the day of play, those who's GA Handicap is higher than the maximum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, but will use the maximum handicap applicable. Those whose GA Handicap is lower than the minimum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, and will use their current daily (playing) handicap for nett prizes.

Note: GOLF NSW Match Committee reserves the right to combine single entries to constitute a pair.

Trophy Presentation will be at conclusion of play.

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2015 in place.

PRIZES

Trophies will be limited to one 36-Hole trophy per player for the tournament and one 18-Hole trophy per player per day.

Division 1 and Division 2 – Singles Stroke Event

36-hole Tournament - Scratch and nett winner; scratch and nett runner-up

18-hole Daily Events - Nett and scratch winner; nett runner-up

Division 3 – Singles Stableford Event

36-hole Tournament - Stableford winner, runner-up, third and fourth places

18-hole Daily Events - Stableford winner, runner-up, and third place

Foursomes - Divisions 1 and Division 2 - Stroke

18-hole Tournament – Scratch and nett winners; nett runners-up and third place nett

Four person Teams V Par

Winners, runners-up and third place awarded over the field at each course
