Welcome to March edition of Drop Zone

As the summer of men's and women's golf comes to an end, our attention will soon focus on Augusta National Golf Club, where Adam Scott will attempt to defend his 2013 Masters title.

With the heightened exposure golf will enjoy in the weeks leading up to, and during the tournament, Golf NSW has embarked on a State wide "Play Golf" radio advertising campaign.

The purpose of the campaign is to promote the game of golf ("the game anyone can play"), and encourage golfers to visit their local Golf Club.

The campaign features Adam Scott and will air on Sydney radio 2GB, in addition to fourteen regional radio stations throughout the State.

The campaign involves a total of 69 broadcasts (39 Regional and 30 Metro), and the call to action is to encourage listeners to visit www.golfnsw.org, to locate their local Golf Club via the Playgolf website, by entering their postcode.

I would ask all Clubs be at a heightened level of enthusiasm, to service any enquires you may receive as a result of the campaign.

If successful, Golf NSW will work closely with all District Golf Associations to assist in driving future marketing/promotion campaigns, to maintain a presence for Golf in what is a very crowded sporting landscape.


