Divisional handicap range may vary depending on the number of entries.

Conditions

1. Format

- 1.1 Played over 18 holes
- 1.2 In the event of a tie for first place, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place getters will be decided by countback.

2. Handicaps

- 2.1 Players to use their first day handicap for the 18 holes.

3. Match Committee

- 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise of representatives from the Golf SA Match Committee and Indigenous Sport.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

4. Rules of Play

- 4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

5. Entries

- 5.1 Eligible players for the championship event are male and female Amateur Golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GOLF SA or other state associations.
- 5.2 **Only players of Aboriginal descent are eligible to win the Championship stroke event.**
- 5.2 No entrance fee is applicable to this event
- 5.3 Entries must be made on the entry form issued by Golf SA, or a facsimile copy thereof. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form. Entries by phone not accepted.
- 5.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 5.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 5.6 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by Golf SA prior to 5:00pm on Monday 21st April 2014. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE

ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEIR ENTRY IS RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES.

6. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting

- 6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of starting.

7. Drug Testing

- 7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

8. Mobile Phones

- 8.1 Mobile phones must be switched off when on the golf course and may only be used in an emergency.

9. Pace of Play

- 9.1 Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered to be out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

10. Motorised Transport

- 10.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Application and approvals to be forwarded with entry form. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

11. Code of Conduct

- 11.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf SA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golfsa.com.au

12. Measuring Devices

- 12.1 For all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only (this does not include applications for mobile phones).

13. Draws

- 13.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf SA website www.golfsa.com.au from Wednesday 23rd April.
