PLAYER INFORMATION

Practice rounds

Practice rounds will be available for tournament entrants for a green fee of \$11 per round for the Friday and Saturday afternoons (after 1pm) preceding the event. Players are also welcome to play in the Members competition on the Thursday and Saturday preceding the event for a Members price of \$15. Bookings can be made through the Pro Shop on 6372 2686.

Format

Play will be from the 1st and 11th tees, from 8.00am. The Women's Championship will be 36-holes over two days. The Men's Championship will be 54-holes over three days, with a seeded draw for the final day.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Scorecards

Players are advised autoscore scorecards will be in use for this event. When signing these cards (on the back of the scorecard), you will be signing for the correctness of the scores as marked in the written number area of the card, as this is the score to count. Players must also mark off the corresponding score in the "lotto style" scoring area.

Rules officials

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food and Beverage

Bacon and egg rolls will be available for purchase for breakfast from 7.00am each day. A standard lunch menu will be available when you come off course. Mudgee Golf Club is providing these services specifically for this event, therefore we would encourage you to have your breakfast and lunch at the Club.

Sunday Welcome Dinner

For those attending the Welcome Dinner on Sunday evening, this will be held in the Clubhouse, from 6.30pm. If you have not booked for this but wish to do so, please contact Olivia Wilson as soon as possible on olivia.wilson@golfnsw.org.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

Winner, Runner Up and Third Place Scratch

Winner and Runner Up Nett

Women's NSW Mid Amateur Championship

Winner, Runner Up Scratch

Winner, Runner Up Nett

Daily scratch and nett winners

Presentation

Presentation of Women's prizes will take place on completion of women's rounds on Monday. Presentation of Men's prizes will be on completion of play on Tuesday. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2015 in place.

Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct

The Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct will apply in accordance with the Championship Entry Conditions. A copy of the Standard Conditions and Code of Conduct is available from the Golf NSW website at www.golfnsw.org.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
