2014 WOMEN'S WEEKEND TOURNAMENT – CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Event Procedure

1.1 The Women's Weekend Tournament will be played as follows:

Saturday – 18-hole single stableford at The Vintage Golf Club on Saturday 23 August.

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Sunday – 18-holes four person teams event v par at The Vintage Golf Club on Sunday 24 August.

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Championship Play Committee

2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.

2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 10), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

4. Entries

4.1 **Handicap:** Eligible players are female amateurs whose GA Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 45 strokes at the time of entry.

4.2 **Age:** There are no age restriction for this event.

4.3 **Entry Fee:** the entry fee applicable for this event is \$160 per player online or \$170 per player for all other forms of entry.

4.4 **Entries:** In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the event, precedence will be given in order of receipt of individual entry. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.

5. Motorised Transport

Motorised Transport is provided for all competitors.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Tournament are at the discretion of the host club.

7. Registration

Competitors MUST register 30 minutes before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value, with a maximum of one prize each day to be awarded to each player:

Saturday - Single Stableford (nett) – Division One and Two

- Winner
- Runner Up
- Third Place
- Ball Competition

Sunday - Teams Event vs Par (A.M. and P.M. are separate competitions)

- Winners
- Runners Up
- Third Place

10. No Smoking Policy

Players are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

11. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.
