

2014 WOMEN'S NSW SAND GREENS CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Championship Procedure

- 1.1 **The Championship** will be scratch stroke play over 36- holes at Barraba Golf Club over two days. Day 1 – 18 holes, Day 2 – 18 holes. Players are required to enter for both days.
- 1.2 The overall scratch winner will be the Women's NSW Sand Greens Champion and will receive the Championship Medal and have their names engraved on the Championship Trophy.
- 1.3 **TIES:** In the event of a tie in the Sand Greens Championship Salver a sudden death play-off will be played, should time permit. Ties in all other events will be determined by the Golf Australia Method of countback.

2. Championship Play Committee

- 2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Match Committee, President of the N&NWDLGA, Secretary of the N&NWDLGA, and Golf NSW General Manager – Golf or their appointees.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card, and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

4. Entries

- 4.1 **Handicap:** Eligible players are female amateurs whose GA Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 45, or who are an exempt player as detailed in Condition 4.5. **No reductions or increases in handicap will be made during the Tournament.** Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play.
- 4.2 **Age:** n/a
- 4.3 **Entry Fee:** The entry fee applicable for this event is \$40 per player.
- 4.4 **Ballot:** In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, applications from those higher handicap competitors will be withdrawn. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 **Exemptions:** There are no exemptions for this Championship.
- 4.6 **Note:** Upon withdrawal, as detailed in the Standard Conditions, a \$10 administration fee is deducted

5. Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission to use motorised transport has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Championship are at the discretion of the host club.

Barraba Golf Club –available at any time for practice rounds with the last tee off time at 3 pm on Friday 8th August. There will be a \$10.00 green fee which will include a ball comp.

7. Registration

Competitors **MUST** register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

NSW Sand Greens Championship. Players may only win one trophy. Prizes will be awarded in the following order:

2014 WOMEN'S NSW SAND GREENS CHAMPIONSHIP – TEAMS EVENT CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the NSW Women's Sand Greens Championship Conditions

1. Teams Event Procedure

- 1.1 The 2014 Women's RLGA Jug will be played concurrently with the 2014 NSW Sand Greens Championship. Regardless of handicap, players may enter together as a Team – Teams of 2 or 3 players, from the same Country District Association or Club, which may enter as many teams as they wish in the event. A player may be nominated in any number of nett teams. In each 18-hole round, the total of the two lowest nett scores of each team each day shall constitute the daily Team Score. The team with the lowest team nett score for the 36-hole event shall be the winner.
- 1.2 The 2014 Women's SWLGA Bowl will be played concurrently with the 2014 NSW Sand Greens Championship. Regardless of handicap, players may enter together as a Team – Teams of 2 or 3 players, from the same Country District Association or Club, which may enter as many teams as they wish in the event. A player may be nominated in any number of scratch teams. In each 18-hole round, the total of the two lowest scratch scores of each team each day shall constitute the daily Team Score. The team with the lowest team scratch score for the 36-hole event shall be the winner.
- 1.3 For both events, the Golf Australia Countback Method will be used should there be a tie, using combined Team Scores..

2. Entries

- 2.1 **Entries:** All competitors in teams must also complete an individual entry form and pay the individual entry fee.
- 2.2 **Entry Fee:** the entry fee applicable for this event is \$40 per individual player. All teams are \$5 per team.

3. Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded for the team events in the following order, with teams eligible for only one team trophy, in addition to any individual event won by a team member.

SWLGA Bowl (Perpetual Trophy) – Winning Team

RLGA Jug (Perpetual Trophy) – Winning Team
