2014 Southern Boys & Girls Championship Notes & Conditions

1. The Championship and Tournament

- 1.1 The Championship will be played over 72 holes stroke play on Mon 29 September at Royal Hobart and Tue 30 September at Colebrook, and is open to all registered golfers with an official Australian handicap of 18.4 for boys and 23.4 for girls or less who are under 18 years of age as at the date of the tournament. If insufficient girls enter the girls entries will be refunded.
- 1.2 The Tournament will be played over 36 holes stroke play on Mon 29 September at Royal Hobart morning only and Tue 30 September at Colebrook morning only, and is open to all registered golfers with an official Australian handicap of 19 for boys and 24 for girls or more who are under 18 years of age as at the date of the tournament. If insufficient girls enter the girls entries will be refunded.

2. Championship Committee

The Championship Committee consists of the SCGA and Royal Hobart's representatives. In the absence of the full Championship Committee such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any such decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.

3. Rules

- 3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such local rules as are provided by the Championship Committee.
- 3.2 The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made to the Committee not later than five minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
- 3.3 The Championship Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to vary any condition of this event.
- 3.4 In the event of a player failing to hand in a card and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the Championship Committee, he will be disqualified from all events in the Championship.

4. Entries

- 4.1 Must be made on the official form and must be accompanied by the Entry Fee. They must be in the hands of the Secretary of the Southern Country Golf Association, PO Box 301, Rosny Park, 7018 or 3 Springvale Avenue, New Town before 5.00pm on Tuesday 16 September 2014.
- 4.2 All handicaps will be fixed by the Championship Committee. The Committee reserves the right to make any alteration in the handicap of any entrant before he starts in each event should it deem desirable.
- 4.3 It is the duty of each competitor to report any reduction in his handicap between the date of entry and the day of play to the starter prior to hitting off.

5. Competitors

The field will be limited to approximately 80 players. Should the field exceed this number the higher handicap players will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded. All references to handicap will be taken as at time of entry.

6. Draw and Starting Times

- 6.1 A draw for the 2 day's play will be made and published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "the player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification provided by Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of this starting time the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes instead of disqualification.
- 6.2 In the event of bad weather or for any other reason the Championship Committee may either shorten the tournament or appoint an alternative date and/or venue for completion of the Championship.

7. Ties

- 7.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined
- 7.2 Ties in handicap events will be decided by count back in accordance with the system approved by the Southern Country Golf Association.

8. The Ball

It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a 1.68" ball which is named in the R&A and/or USGA Approved Lists. Copies of these will be made available at the Course.

9. Honorary Members

All competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Host Golf Club on the respective day of play.

10. Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. 11. GPS Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
