IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

Registration must be done prior to commencing play with Golf NSW (an administration area will be set up in the Clubhouse). Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register.

SCORECARDS

Players are advised autoscore scorecards will be in use for this event. When signing these cards (on the back of the scorecard), you will be signing for the correctness of the written number scores. To assist with administration, players are also requested to mark the "lotto style" scoring area of the card.

SCORE CARD RETURN AND SCORING

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated administration area in the clubhouse. Please ensure you have noted your handicap and have two signatures before submitting. Scores will be posted in the Clubhouse.

RULES OFFICIALS

There will be a roving rules official on course on the day of play. You will be given a handout on the tee outlining a phone number you can call should you require a rules official for a ruling.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Woollahra Golf Club will provide tea/coffee and biscuits the morning of the event. A standard lunch menu will be available following your round. As Woollahra Golf Club are providing these services specifically for this event, we would encourage you to have your lunch at the Club if possible.

USE OF MOTORIZED CARTS

As per the conditions of entry, participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission must be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

PRESENTATION

The presentation will be conducted at the completion of play in the Clubhouse. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

WITHDRAWAL

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2015 in place.

CONDITIONS FOR STATE EVENTS AND CODE OF CONDUCT

The Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct will apply in accordance with the Championship Entry Conditions. A copy of the Standard Conditions and Code of Conduct is available from the Golf NSW website at www.golfnsw.org.

PLAYER AND CADDY RESPONSIBILITIES

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
