PLAYING CONDITIONS

1. Royal Hobart Cup will be 36 holes stroke play – total GROSS score to count.
2. In the event of bad weather or for any other reason the Championship Committee may either shorten the Championship or appoint an alternate date for the completion of the Championship.
3. The Championship will be a seeded draw which will be made available on Friday 22nd August 2014
4. Motorised Cart usage must be supported by a medical certificate supplied to the Club Administration Staff. (Refer By Law 3 - k).
To use a motorised golf cart in any Club Championship event a player must present a Doctor's Certificate confirming the inability of the member to walk the course for the event. The player must not carry any other player who has not produced a certificate. Should this rule be breached the player who rode in the cart without a certificate will be automatically disqualified from the event.
5. **Ties:** In the event of a tie in gross Championships, a playoff, as determined by the Championship Committee, will be held on the day. All other ties will be decided by count-back.
6. Play is off the Championship (Blue) Blocks.

DRESS CODE

April 2014

Each member owes a duty to his/her fellow Members to maintain standards befitting Royal Hobart Golf Club. It is the responsibility of all Members to ensure that their guests conform to the regulations of the Club. Whilst we have adjusted our dress code in line with modern trends, we ask that members and guests dress in good taste at all times.

Any variance to the regulations stated below, are at the discretion of the General Manager or his delegate.

CLUBHOUSE

The Dress Code in all areas of the Clubhouse is smart casual attire.

ACCEPTABLE:

- Clean soft spike golf shoes may be worn in the Clubhouse except in the Royal Dining Room.
- Denim – not torn/ripped.
- Leather boat shoes and dress sandals may be worn in the clubhouse without socks.

NOT PERMITTED:

- Tracksuits, logoed Tee shirts, singlets and cargo trousers.

ON COURSE

Club Policy requires all players to be neatly dressed.

ACCEPTABLE:

- Neat trousers or shorts/skirts.
- Shirts with a collar or turtle neck.
- For men, shirts must be tucked in.
- Neat, clean trainers may be worn in place of golf shoes.

NOT PERMITTED:

- Metal spiked golf shoes.
- Blue denim, cargo shorts, singlets and track suits are not accepted.
- The wearing of predominantly dark/coloured socks is not permitted with shorts or skirts.

CHILDREN

Children's attire should at all times be neat and appropriate to their usage of the Club's facilities. It is permissible for children to wear neat, clean jeans on the course.
