2014 WOMEN'S MOUNTAIN MEETING – CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

Event Procedure

The Women's Mountain Meeting will be played as follows:

Monday 20 & Tuesday 21 October - 18-holes stroke (Divisions 1 & 2), 18-holes stableford (Division 3)

Ties: In the event of tie with all Perpetual Trophies there will be joint winners, all other ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Players will play off the same handicap on days 1&2, then be handicapped after round 2 and play off current handicaps on days 3 and 4.

Wednesday 22 October - 18-holes foursomes

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Thursday 23 October - 18-holes teams v par

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Championship Play Committee

- The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Women's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.
- In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 10), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

Entries

- GA Handicap: Eligible players are amateurs whose GA Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 45.4 strokes at the time of entry. Should a player's GA handicap on the day of play be above the handicap limit in their allocated division they will play off the maximum GA handicap for that division throughout the duration of the event. Should a player's GA handicap on the day be below the handicap limit they will play off their current handicap for the duration of the event.
- 4.2 Age: n/a.
- Entry Fee: the entry fee applicable for this event is \$45 for one day or \$120 for 4 days, per player (NOTE: Online entry is only \$35 for one game or \$110 for 4 days, per player)
- 4.4 Ballot: In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the event, precedence will be given in order of receipt of entry. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 Exemptions: There are no exemptions for this Championship.

Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission MUST be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Tournament are at the discretion of the host club. Permission must be sought from the host club and practice times may be booked directly with the Professional Shop.
