## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### FORMAT

#### Thursday 18 September

18-holes stroke handicap, with the aggregate of the Club's four players being used to determine the Club's score.

**Ties:** In the event of a tie in the Bronze Medallion, such clubs will be declared joint winners. Ties for all other events are to be determined by countback using individual or all players' aggregate scores, as appropriate.

### REGISTRATION

Registration must be done each day prior to play with Golf NSW (an administration area will be set up in the clubhouse). Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register.

### SCORECARDS

Players are advised autoscore scorecards will be in use for this event. When signing these cards (on the back of the scorecard), you will be signing for the correctness of the written number, as this is the score to count. It is requested that players also mark the "lotto style" scoring area of the card, to assist with processing scorecards.

### SCORE CARD RETURN AND SCORING

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated administration area in the clubhouse. Scores will be posted in the Clubhouse.

### RULES OFFICIALS

There will be a roving rules official on course. You will be given a handout on the tee outlining a phone number you can call should you require a rules official for a ruling.

### FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Food and drinks will be available for purchase, before and after your round at each club.

#### Wakehurst Golf Club

Before Golf – Tea and coffee, Clubhouse Menu from 6:30am.

After Golf – Clubhouse Menu.

#### Monash Golf Club

Before Golf – Cafeteria style service – tea and coffee, cereal, muffins, fruit salad and yogurt.

After Golf – Soups, salads, melts and main meals.

### PRESENTATION

Trophy Presentation will be held at conclusion of play at Wakehurst Golf Club. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

### DRESS REGULATIONS

All entrants must comply with the host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

### WITHDRAWAL

### DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2015 in place.

### MOTORISED CARTS

Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

### CADDIES

Caddies are not permitted.

### PRIZES

The Bronze Medallion will be won by the best aggregate nett score of four (4) players within the prescribed handicap limits entering from the same club. Players may receive one individual prize only, in addition to the Bronze Medallion.

Bronze Medallion - winner and runner up teams

18-hole scratch and nett singles events in conjunction at both courses
