MAXIMUM HANDICAP LIMIT Men: 36 Women: 45

Handicap Grades Men: A: 0 – 12 B: 13 – 18 C: 19 – 27 D: 28 – 36 Ladies: 0 - 45 Seniors: 55 years & over

The VANDERFIELD OPEN will be played over 36 holes stroke play at Humpty Doo Golf Club. Round 1: Saturday 4th October Round 2: Sunday 5th October

There will be a limit of 112 players.

Entries close Wednesday 1st October. Late entries may be accepted depending on the number of nominations.

Round 1 will not be seeded. Players may nominate their preferred tee off time. This is not guaranteed. Round 2 will be a seeded draw (best 8 gross scores in men's grades, best 4 gross scores in women's grades).

Seeded players must play in their seeded group to be eligible for the Championship.

The draw for each round will be available after 8pm Thursday 2nd October& Saturday 4th October on the club website <u>www.humptydoogolfclub.com.au</u> or by phoning the club on 8988 1118.

Eligible players must be a financial member of a recognised affiliated club and must have a Golf Australia or equivalent handicap. Handicaps will not be adjusted for dailies or over the entire event.

Prizes will be awarded for:

Daily Gross & Nett Winners:Men's A, B C & D grades, LadiesOverall Gross & Nett Winners:Men's A, B C & D grades, LadiesOverall Runners up:Men's A, B C & D grades, LadiesOverall Senior:Gross & NettOverall Champion:Men & LadiesDaily NTP:Men & LadiesDaily NTP:Men & LadiesDaily Longest Drive:Men's A, B C & D grades, Ladies

There is no limit to the number of prizes which may be won by any one person.

In the event of a tie for the overall gross events for all grades, there will be a sudden-death hole by hole playoff until a winner is determined.

There is no restriction on the use of motorised buggies by any player. Players may obtain distance information by using a device which measures distance only.

Rule 6-3a will be applied if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes of his starting time. The penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes instead of disqualification.

SLOW PLAY: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. 2 STROKE penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Any special requests from players travelling together, sharing motorised carts etc. should be noted on your nomination form. Your requests will be considered but approval is not guaranteed.

These conditions may be altered at any time at the discretion of the Humpty Doo & Rural Area Golf Club Match Committee.
