

## Playgolf WEEK Primary Schools Mini-Golf Hole Competition: Terms & Conditions

- 1 Entry is free and open to all primary schools in Australia. Each primary school may enter more than once, however only one entry per year level per school is permitted.
- 2 Schools who employ employees and their immediate families of the Promoter, their related corporate bodies and Agencies are not eligible to enter.
- 3 The promotion commences at 9.00 am AEST on 1 October 2014 and closes at 11.59 pm AEDT on 23 November 2014.
- 4 To enter, schools must design a mini-golf hole. The hole may be a drawn diagram, a clay or paper-mache sculpture, a structure containing obstacles built on the oval or in the school playground, etc.
- 5 To submit the entry:
  - a. Email a diagram, picture or video link of the hole to [mygolf@golf.org.au](mailto:mygolf@golf.org.au) and include in the subject line "MyGolf Schools Competition Entry". If the file is too large to send, it may be sent via Dropbox or other similar means.
  - b. Upload a diagram, picture or video link of the hole and post it on Twitter with the hashtag #playgolfweek and ideally handle in @playgolfweek.
  - c. Upload a diagram, picture or video link of the hole and post it on Instagram with the video link in the caption space and the hashtag #playgolfweek.
  - d. Upload a diagram, picture or video link of the hole and post it on the Golf Australia Facebook Page (GolfAust).
  - e. Upload a diagram, picture or video of the hole onto a USB and mail it to Golf Australia (Level 3, 95 Coventry St, South Melbourne VIC 3205).
  - f. Take a photo of the hole and mail it to Golf Australia (Level 3, 95 Coventry St, South Melbourne VIC 3205).
  - g. Fax a photo or diagram of the hole to Golf Australia (03 9626 5095).
  - h. Any other means by which the hole may be viewed by the Promoters.
- 6 The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process or for submitting an entry which is not in accordance with these Conditions of Entry.
- 7 All eligible entries will be reviewed by a panel of judges from the Promoter on or before 5.00 pm AEDT on 25 November 2014 at Golf Australia, Level 3, 95 Coventry St, South Melbourne Vic 3205. The entry judged the most creative as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion, will be awarded the Prize.
- 8 The Prize is a MyGolf Schools Kit valued at AUD\$550; a maximum of a 1-hour golf clinic at the winning school with a Golf Australia Rookie Squad Member; and a \$500 Coles/Myer voucher. The MyGolf Schools Kit and Coles/Myer voucher will be sent to the winning school within four (4) weeks of the winner being advised. The MyGolf Clinic may be held at a time convenient to both the school and the Rookie Squad Member, and must be redeemed between 1 December 2014 and 30 June 2015.
- 9 If the winning school cannot be contacted by email or phone by 5.00 pm AEDT on 28 November 2014, is not able to satisfy these Terms and Conditions, or forfeits or fails to accept their Prize by 5.00 pm AEDT on 28 November 2014, then they will be deemed to have forfeited their entitlement to their Prize in its entirety and it shall be awarded to next best valid entry selected.
- 10 The winner of the competition (and their hole) will be announced via <http://www.playgolf.com.au/> by 11.00 am AEDT on 1 December 2014.
- 11 The prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
- 12 The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13 The winner agrees to the use of their name, image, likeness, and photograph/s for publicity and promotional purposes as reasonably required by the Promoter, without royalties or other compensation, in any medium (including without limitation print and electronic media) and agrees that the Promoter will own copyright in any such images and photograph/s and in all material incorporating such images and photograph/s.
- 14 If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned (whether caused by infection by computer virus, line drop out, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other cause beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity of the promotion), the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion, (subject to any written direction given by a relevant regulatory authority), to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion. The Promoter may in its sole discretion disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, provides false information or similar.
- 15 The Promoter may collect personal information about the entrant for the purpose of including the entrant in the promotion and, where appropriate, to award prizes. If the entrant does not provide the Promoter with their personal details, the Promoter may not be able to enter the entrant in the promotion.
- 16 The Promoter may also use the entrant's information to assist it in improving its goods and services and to contact the entrant, including by electronic communication methods (such as email and SMS) in the future with special offers.
