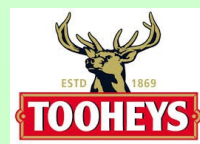

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Events are open to Amateur golfers having a current Australian handicap with an Affiliated Golf Club.
2. Handicap Divisions covering all events to be determined by the Tournament Committee after a receipt of entries.
3. Unless full **Golf Link Number** is provided a handicap card must be available for perusal by the Committee.
4. The Tournament Committee has the sole control of the Tournament. Any dispute or protest will be decided by the Tournament Committee and their decision will be final (Rule 34-3)
5. The Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry, setting handicap grades. Handicaps will remain per the first round of each event.
6. Only one trophy may be won per person per event.
7. The Rules of Golf and Local Rules apply for the duration of the Tournament. The 2BBB stableford events in conjunction with single stableford events shall be played under The Rules of Golf pertaining to a single stableford event.
8. No card will be accepted after results have been declared. Visitors results will be sent to home clubs at the conclusion of the Tournament.
9. In the event of a tie a play off will decide the winner.
10. Entries must be nominated on the Entry Form, or photocopy of the Entry Form, and be accompanied by a cheque, money order, cash or credit card payment. Entries close on Friday 10th April 2015, or for each event, when a capacity field is reached.
11. Preferred tee times allocated to entries as they are received.
12. All players must report to the starter 15 minutes before hit-off time. Any player not adhering to this condition may be disqualified.
13. Late entries for the 36 holes event will be accepted if vacancies exist.
14. Metal spikes not permitted.
15. The Committee reserves the right to alter any condition above should this action become necessary.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. A copy of the draw will be listed on our website in the preceding week. Results will also be listed on our website after the conclusion of the 3 days. Daily results will be displayed on the Clubhouse notice board.
2. In accordance with the prevailing laws it is necessary for each visitor to sign in on their arrival. Contact club Reception for any assistance. All the facilities of the Clubhouse are available to you during your visit. The Clubhouse opens each day at 9.00am.
3. Cancellations and Refunds: No Refunds will be made for any cancellation received less than seven days before the first day of the tournament, except cancellations on medical grounds or incapacity will be given consideration. If a refund is to be made than a booking fee of five dollars (\$5) will be retained. Substitutes must be authorised by the Tournament Director at his/her Discretion. (additional entry fee will apply)
