### Tournament Function:

*Australian Men's Senior Match Play Championship: Presentation Luncheon:*

Wednesday 17 June at the conclusion of play: approximately 1.30 pm ~ 2.30 pm at Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club.

The cost is \$30.00 per person. Please note that drinks are NOT INCLUDED. Places should be purchased at the time of entry however, subject to numbers, places may still be purchased up until Registration Day. Dress – golfing attire or casual (no jeans).

**Registration:**

Competitors are required to register between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm on Sunday 14 June at Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club. At this time, competitors will be required to provide a phone number where they can be contacted during the event. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship.

If it is impossible to register in person, competitors must contact Adam Power at Championship Office on registration day on 0448 366 224.

**Withdrawals:**

Please contact Golf Australia immediately on 03 9626 5050 if you are unable to compete. As per condition 10, once a player has been eliminated from the main championship, they are not permitted to withdraw from subsequent rounds unless on the receipt of a medical certificate, or in exceptional circumstances (as determined by the Championship Play Committee). Any player withdrawing from the Championship for a non-approved reason may have their entry into the 2016 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championship declined.

**Results & Draws:**

All results and draws will be posted at [www.golf.org.au](http://www.golf.org.au). The final draw for round 1 will be available after 5.00 pm on Sunday 14 June.

**Practice Round:**

**ONE** complimentary practice round is available for players between 11am – 1pm on Sunday 14 June. Players **MUST** make a booking with the pro shop on 07 5524 4644. Play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

**Range Facilities and Balls:**

A practice fairway and putting green are available. Practice balls are available from the driving range for warm-up purposes only.

**Motorised Carts:**

The cost of a shared golf cart for all Championship Rounds is included in the entry fee and these have been reserved. A cart for the practice round is **NOT** included. Players must book a cart via the pro shop on 07 5524 4644 if this is required.

Players who would prefer their own cart **MUST** advise this on the entry form, and an additional charge of \$75.00 will apply. Every effort will be made to ensure all carts requests are accommodated.

**Caddies:**

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddie they must make their own arrangements.

**Dress Requirements:**

"Hard/Metal" spikes are not permitted. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted.

**Distance Measuring Devices:**

In this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (eg gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

**Mobile Phones:**

Players must have mobile phones turned off at all times whilst on the golf course during competition play except if being used solely as a Distance Measuring Device or to ring a Tournament Official for a ruling.

**Golf Australia Hard Card:**

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

**Smoking:**

Players are not permitted to smoke cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. A competitor failing to adhere to this regulation will be in breach of Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

**Course Care:**

All clubs which host Golf Australia National Championships kindly give up their course to you for the duration of the event. Hence, so that the course is left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed, players **MUST** carry **AND** use a sand bucket and repair divots. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.
