- * As per HRDGA Ladies Standard Conditions of Play & Host Club Local Rules
- * The Tournament Match Committee shall comprise members of the HRDGA Ladies Committee
- * A Tie in the Open or Closed Scratch Championship & Foursomes Championship will be decided by a 3 Hole Playoff:
Holes to be determined. If all square then sudden death over these same holes.
- * Ties in all other events will be decided by GA recommended countback method.
- * The Closed Scratch & Nett Championship is open only to lady players affiliated with HRDGA
- * A limit of one Trophy per player. If the same player wins both the Open & Closed Scratch Event she will be presented with both Perpetual Trophies but only one Voucher.
- * Players will be drawn to play in fours where possible
- * A step-up draw will apply in case of cancellation after completion of Draw.
- * The Draw will be on the HRDGA website, emailed to all clubs & sent via mail to those requesting same.

HOST CLUB:

To Host a HRDGA Ladies event, the ladies from the club must be affiliated with HRDGA.
Daily Competition results will be entered into Golfink by the Host Club at the completion of Play.

COMPETITION:

To be eligible to enter any HRDGA Ladies Event, a player must be an Amateur and have a current GA handicap

The HRDGA Ladies Sub-Committee reserves the right to refuse entry and settle all disputes.

The Tournament Match Committee shall be the HRDGA Ladies Sub-Committee members

All players must enter on their Golf Australia handicap and play off the Daily Handicap applicable to the host club. Players must be able to provide proof of handicap. The recording of the correct handicap is the responsibility of the player.

A Competition Card is classed as being 'returned' when the player has left the official scoring table.

CADDIES:

Caddies are not permitted in any HRDGA Ladies organised event.

MOTORISED TRANSPORT:

Motorised Transport is permitted

TELEPHONES:

Use of Mobile Phones is not encouraged. Serious breach of Etiquette may result in disciplinary action.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Golf NSW'S Code of Conduct shall apply to all events and competitions organised by HRDGA Ladies Committee

LIGHTNING:

It is the player's responsibility to take cover and/or leave the course if she considers she maybe in danger during lightning strikes.

HEAT POLICY:

The HRDGA Heat Policy shall apply to all Ladies Events.
