2015 WOMEN'S AUTUMN MEETING – CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Event Procedure

1.1 The Women's Autumn Meeting will be played as follows:

Monday 4 & Tuesday 5 May - 18-holes stroke (Divisions 1 & 2)

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System

Wednesday 6 May - 18-holes foursomes

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Thursday 7 May - 18-holes teams v par

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Championship Committee

- 2.1 The Championship Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Match & Rules Committee, Golf NSW General Manager Golf, and Director Rules, or their appointees.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card, and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committ

4. Entries

- 4.1 **GA Handicap**: Eligible players are amateurs whose GA Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 45.4 strokes at the time of entry. Should a players GA handicap on the day of play be above the handicap limit in their allocated division they will play off the maximum GA handicap for that division throughout the duration of the event. Should a players GA handicap on the day be below the GA handicap limit they will play off their current GA handicap for the duration of the event.
- 4.2 Age: n/a.
- 4.3 Entry Fee: the entry fee applicable for this event is \$45 per game or \$120 for 4 days, per player (NOTE: Online entry is only \$35 per game or \$110 for 4 days, per player)
- 4.4 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the event, <u>precedence will be given in order of receipt of entry</u>. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 Any player who has her golf playing membership or handicap at the date of the Contest suspended by Golf Australia, Golf NSW, any Club who is a member of Golf NSW / Golf Australia, or a District Golf Association, is not eligible to participate.
- 4.6 **Exemptions**: There are no exemptions for this Championship.

Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission MUST be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

This Condition is in place to ensure that all those who require motorised transport are able to participate. Should you require motorised transport for only a particular day or course because you are unable to walk, then please ensure that your letter from your medical practitioner or Club Official states this requirement.

6 Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Tournament are at the discretion of the host club. Permission must be sought from the host club and practice times may be booked directly with the Professional Shop.
