2. The event is open to amateurs who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf NT or golf clubs registered with such state or overseas associations recognised by Golf NT and who have a current Australian Handicap, official Club Handicap or recognised overseas handicap.
3. It is required that all competitors report in person to the Starter at least 10 minutes prior to their allotted tee timings.

The Palmerston Open 2015 **Conditions of Entry**

1. The Open will be conducted over 36 holes, 18 holes Saturday and 18 holes Sunday
2. In the event of a tie or ties for the Open, (unless the Match Committee otherwise determines) play shall continue over such holes as the Match Committee shall decide with players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality until a winner is determined.
3. The Open will be under the management and control of the Tournament Committee consisting of members of the Palmerston Golf Club.
4. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply, together with such local rules as are approved by the Committee.
5. The decision of the Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made to the Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play, except on the final day when they must be made within 5 minutes of the conclusion of play.
6. The Committee reserves the right to vary any conditions of this event and/or cancel all or any section of this event.
7. A draw for each day's play will be made. Players shall report in person to the starter at least 10 minutes before their published starting times and shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this tournament that if a player arrives at the starting point, ready to play within 5 minutes after the published starting time (in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7), the penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes instead of disqualification.
8. The Committee reserves the right to fix or alter starting times.
9. Maximum Handicaps: Men-36; Ladies-45; subject to number of entries.
NOTE: Handicaps will not be altered during the course of the tournament.

NB- Visitors - Proof of Exact Handicap must be produced to the starter prior to the commencement of play.

10. Practice on the competition course is not permitted during the tournament. Refer to Rule 7-1b.
11. Speed of Play. – Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course in respect to the group preceding them. Any groups with a clear hole in front shall be considered to be out of position. Penalties shall be issued to individuals in such groups who, by their pace, contribute to such play. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
12. Motorised Buggies: All motorised buggies must comply with the policy of PGCC and be registered under the NT Motor Vehicle Act. Please note that motorised buggies may be used during this event.
13. All players must enter their completed card into the scoring computer within 15 minutes of completing their round. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
