PLAYER INFORMATION

Practice rounds

Mt Broughton Golf & Country Club - Practice rounds are available at Member-Guest rates for NSW Mixed Foursomes competitors. Please book with the golf shop on 02 4868 3200.

Format

Play will be from the 1st & 10th tees, from 8:30am. The Championship will be over 18-holes.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Rules officials

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food and Beverage

Mt Broughton will be providing a sausage sizzle for Mixed Foursomes competitors at no charge to players. This will be available after your round. Drinks can be purchased by players through the club.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

- Runners Up Scratch
- Third Place Scratch
- Winners Nett
- Runners Up Nett
- Champion of Champions

Presentation

Presentation will take place upon completion of play. If you are able to remain for this, please do so. Golf NSW will be providing nibbles and drinks during presentation also.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
