CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. The Glenelg Senior Amateur will be played as a Stroke play over 18 holes.
- 2. All players must have an official Golf Australia handicap. Eligibility: open to male amateurs aged 55 years or older on 24th August 2015 with a Golf Australia handicap of 15.6 or less at the time of entry. Players entering the Super Seniors event must be aged 65 years or older.
- 3. Play will be from the White tees.
- 4. The field will be strictly limited. In the event of entries exceeding this limit, a handicap ballot will apply.
- 5. In the event of a tie for placings, a countback will apply.
- 6. The use of a motorised cart is permitted however preference will be given to players who have a medical Certificate. A person may not bring on to the course any personal motorised transport.
- 7. Competitors must start at the appointed time. Rule 6-3 will apply.
- 8. The Match Committee of Glenelg Golf Club will make playing arrangements and be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
- 9. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
- 10. Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of Glenelg Golf Club.
- 11. A presentation will be held immediately after all the results are posted. Players are not Permitted to win more than one major prize.
