'B' GRADE ZONE CHAMPIONSHIP MEETING 2015

Conditions of Entry

1. Entries will only be accepted upon payment of entry fee.
2. Late entries will be accepted at the host club's discretion.
3. Refunds will be available until entries close.
4. After entries close refunds will only be made at the discretion of the Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group Women.
5. Lunch, the menu for which is at the discretion of the host club, is provided.

Conditions of Play

1. This event is conducted under the auspices of Golf SA, the Southern Golf Group Women, and under the Rules of the "R & A Golf Club of St. Andrews" and the local rules of the host club.
2. The Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group Women will be the arbiter of any dispute or matters arising from the event.
3. Only women members of Golf Clubs affiliated with the Southern Golf Group Women are eligible to enter.
4. Players must have a Golf Australia handicap and be able to verify it if requested.
5. **The GA Handicap limit for this event is 20.1- 28.0**
Any player whose GA handicap exceeds **28.0** before the day of play may remain in the B grade event playing on the handicap limit. (as per Golf SA events)
A player who reduces her GA handicap below **20.1** before the day of play may apply for a transfer to the next event. Alternatively she may continue in the entered event on her reduced handicap, in the Net event only. The Gross event cannot be won by any player not in the appropriate handicap event.
6. In the event of a tie in any gross event a "sudden death" play-off will take place starting at the first hole.
7. In the event of a tie in a net event the tie will be determined as follows:
Score on back 9 holes (10-18) – use ½ hcp
If tied countback on the final 6 holes - use ⅓ hcp
If still tied countback on the final 3 holes – use 1/6 hcp
If still tied countback hole by hole from 18th
8. A player may not win both a gross and net event.
The gross event takes precedence over the net event.
A player may not win more than one trophy except for Veteran event.
9. To promote participation in this event, motorized transport may be used, without the need for a medical certificate.
10. Measuring Devices – The use of a personal measuring device (this does not include applications for mobile phones) by a competitor or caddy is permitted under the following condition:
The device must measure DISTANCE ONLY; it must not measure other conditions such as wind speed or direction, the slope of the ground or the temperature.
11. Play may be in groups of four (4) with the lowest handicap players hitting off first.
12. Players must report to the Starter at least 30 minutes before starting time. If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.
13. Trophies will be presented on the day of play.
In the event of cancellation of play trophies will not be awarded.
If 9 holes have been completed by the whole field, trophies will be awarded.
