Conditions of Play

| Eligibility | Amateur players who hold a current Golf Australia handicap and who have paid the entry fee as set down in the Competition Fees List for this event are eligible to play. |
| Handicap | GA Handicap limit is 18.5 to 26.6 |
| Fee | For Ladies of the Club the Competition Fee for the Pennant Hills Cup, as set down in the current year's Competition Fee list, must be paid. For guests to the Club, the fee will be determined by the Ladies Committee. |
| Entry and Draw | Ladies will enter the Pennant Hills Cup using the Club website or kiosks in the Clubhouse. Guests to the Club will enter using the Guest Website or by submitting an entry form. Times will be drawn by the Committee and published as appropriate. The draw will be seeded. Players with the highest handicaps will hit off first. Late entries will be accepted and will be added to the draw at the discretion of the Match Committee. |
| Conditions of Play | This is a scratch event, Stroke, over 18 holes. There will be an 18 hole nett event and ball competition in conjunction. |
| Starting Times | The Match Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times. |
| Motorised Transport | Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorised by the Match Committee OR exempted as detailed in General Conditions for Ladies Competitions, paragraph 1.8b |
| Ties | In the event of a tie in either the Gross or the Nett events, the Golf Australia Method of Countback will be used to determine the Winners. |
| Withdrawals and Forfeits | Players who withdraw before the draw has been completed, or players whose change of handicap at any time makes them ineligible for the competition, will be entitled to a full refund of the entry fee. Players who withdraw after the draw has been completed will forfeit the entry fee. |
| Caddies | Caddies are permitted. |
| Half-way House | There will be no half-way house for competitors in this event. However, players may obtain refreshment provided they do not delay play of the next hole. |
| Disputes | Disputes and queries must be reported to the Captain or Match Committee at the same time as the player submits her completed score card. |
| Daily Prizes | A player may win only one of the three Prizes: Best Gross, Runner-up to Gross and Best Nett. The Best Gross and Runner-Up to Gross Prizes will take precedence over the Best Nett. The value of the Best Nett shall not exceed that of Runner-up to Gross. There will be a ball rundown. Pennant Hills Cup: Winner of the Gross event to have name inscribed on the Cup. Trophy Vouchers for Gross Winner and Runner-up . Trophy Voucher for Nett Winner. |
