Handicap limits: 12 - Open & Closed; 18 - B Grade; 24 – all other Championships and all nett events.

Entries close at 8pm, Tuesday 3rd November 2015 (Refer 24, Conditions).

Conditions

1. The events are open to male amateurs, as defined by the Amateur Status Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia.
2. Players under the age of 18 years as at the last day of the competition are eligible for the Junior Championship.
3. Players who are aged 18 – 23 inclusive as at the last day of the competition are eligible for the Colts Championship.
4. Players who are aged 50 years or over as on the first day of the event are eligible for the Seniors 36 Hole Championship.
5. The rules of golf and the local rules of the Host Club shall be the rules of play during the Championship.
6. The G.N.W. Executive reserves the right to make any alterations to the starting times and programme and to refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
7. All disputes and protests must be lodged with the Committee not later than 5 minutes after the end of play on the day in which the disputed matter has arisen and the decision of the Executive Committee of the G.N.W. on all points shall be final.
8. The field will be limited to approximately 80 players. In the event of excessive entries, the Executive of G.N.W. has the power to ballot at their discretion.
9. All references to handicap to be taken as at first day of competition.
10. All handicaps will be fixed by the championship committee of G.N.W. The Committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the handicap of any player before they start in each event should it deem desirable.
11. Players will be graded in accordance with their Australian Handicap as shown on their entry form.
12. In the event of a player failing to hand in a card after each round and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the Championship Committee, that player shall be disqualified from all events in the Championship.
13. If a competitor fails to report for any round, fails to meet all his playing obligations and fails to submit a satisfactory reason to the Committee, future entries for the next four (4) tournaments may be refused.
14. Golf Balls: It will be obligatory for all players in the championship to play with a 1.68 ball which is named in the current R&A and/or USGA approved lists.
15. Balls with identical markings: Throughout a stipulated round, the player is limited to use golf balls with identical markings, except that the player identification numbers may differ by number only, but not by colour. Penalty: Stroke play – 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred, maximum penalty per round 4 strokes.
16. Competitors must report to starter 15 minutes before appointed hit off time.
17. Pace of Play: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced.
18. During a round, competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle.
19. Host Club's dress regulations must be observed at all times.
20. Ties in the Championship shall be decided by a "sudden death" play-off over such holes as the G.N.W. Executive Committee determines. Ties in all other events to be decided by count-back in accordance with the approved system.
21. Draw and Starting Times: A draw for each day's play will be made and published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that, as provided by rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point ready to play within 5 minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes instead of disqualification.
22. The Executive Committee of G.N.W. reserves the right to close the whole or any portion of the course for any period they deem necessary, either before or during the Championship.
23. In the event of bad weather or for any other reason, the committee may shorten the event or appoint an alternative date and / or venue for the completion of the Championship.
24. Entries must be on the prescribed form and MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE. Entries close with the Administrative Officer of Golf North West, 16 Locket Street, Ulverstone 7315 at 8:00 pm Tuesday 3rd November 2015. Phone entries will not be accepted
25. Entries received after this deadline MAY be accepted if the size of the field permits, but if accepted will incur a penalty of \$10.00.
26. Competitors and their caddies should abstain from consuming alcohol on the course during the Championship.
