2015 VICTORIAN FAMILY CHAMPIONSHIP - TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- 1.1 The 2015 Victorian Family Championship will consist of three sections; Men's, Women's, and Mixed. The respective sections are open to pairs as specified below:
 - Men's Section two male players
 - Women's Section two female players
 - Mixed Section one male and one female player
- 1.2 The format is 18 holes 4BBB Stableford per section. All sections will play in the afternoon of Sunday 29 November via a multi-tee start.
- 1.3 The winning pairs in each section shall be the pair who has the highest 4BBB Stableford points at the 18 hole event.
- 1.4 Entries will be accepted on an as received basis. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.
- 1.5 The field for the Championship will consist of a maximum of 60 pairs. Positions will be reserved for a minimum of 12 men's, 12 women's and 12 mixed pairs.
- 1.6 Each pair must have an immediate family relationship (stepparents, adopted parents and de-facto inclusive) which must be stated on the entry form. Some examples of eligible Family Championship team combinations are found below:
 - Father/Son
 - Father/Daughter
 - Mother/Son
 - Mother/Daughter
 - Husband/Wife
 - Husband/whileBrothers
 - Sisters
 - Brother/Sister
 - Uncle/Nephew
 - Uncle/Niece

- Aunt/Nephew
- Aunt/Niece
- Grandparent/Grand-son or daughter
- First Cousins
- Father/Daughter or son in law
- Mother/Daughter or son in law

All eligible queries of this nature are to be directed to the Golf Victoria Match Committee whose decision shall be final.

1.7 In the event of a tie for the Championship in the Men's, Women's or Mixed Section, all positions shall be decided by the system of countback as specified by Golf Australia.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The event is open to male and female players whose individual GA handicap does not exceed 36.4 (men) and 45.4 (women) stokes in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System at date of entry. Players may be an amateur or professional.
- 2.2 Professional's Handicaps Professional's handicaps for the Victorian Family Championship are to be determined as follows: -
 - (i) Where a professional is a member of a club <u>or</u> has a handicap calculated at a club where he/she is employed, then that handicap shall apply for the Victorian Family Championship.
 - (ii) If (i) above is not applicable, Professionals are to play from scratch.

Exception: All professionals who hold playing rights on any PGA or LPGA Tour shall be allocated a playing handicap by the Championship Committee.

3. ENTRIES

- **3.1** The entry fee is \$100.00 (incl. GST) per pair per event. This includes a light lunch for the pair. Entry fee must be paid at time of entry.
- 3.2 Golf Victoria shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- **3.3** Entries shall only be made on the official entry form or online at www.golfvic.org.au.
- 3.4 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at www.golfvic.org.au approximately one week before the event.
- 3.5 Entry forms that are received before the specified opening date will not be accepted.

4. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to:

- Winner (all sections) Family Championship
- Runner-Up (all sections)

5. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of Golf Victoria representatives and the Match Committee of the Club upon whose course the rounds are being played. In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round.

6. REFUND POLICY

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded provided notification is received within **three working days** prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical Certificate).

7. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under Championships & Events → Resources → GV Motorised Transport for the return form and more information. **Exemption:** Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Victoria cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a <u>limited</u> number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player ONLY when sufficient carts are available.
