2015 CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- 1.1 The 2015 Champion of Champions will be played over two rounds of 18 holes stroke play over two days, Sunday 15 to Monday 16 November 2014.
- 1.2 In the instance the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, a **ballot by entry** will occur. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.
- 1.3 **Substitutes** – Players may not be substituted
- 1.4 If a competitor alters her handicap during the course of the Competition, her original handicap shall prevail throughout for all prizes. Players must play from their current handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit of 45.4 strokes.
- 1.5 In the event of a tie for the Joan Fisher Trophy, a play-off is to be staged if time permits, otherwise a count-back will be utilised. The play-off will be played at a time and in a manner as decided by the Championship Committee. Ties for all other positions shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Open to the most recent female amateur Champions whose Golf Australia handicap does not exceed 45 at the time of entry and who have won the Club Championship of Golf Victoria affiliated golf clubs, or winners of the following State Championships between 21 November 2014 and 14 November 2015:
 - Country District Championship
 - Victorian Women's Senior Championship
 - Victorian Women's Weekend Championship
 - Victorian Women's Amateur Championship
 - Victorian Junior Girls' Championship
 - Victorian Women's Country Championship
 - Victorian Women's Sandgreens Championship
 - Victorian Women's Par 3 Championship
 - Victorian Women's Mid-Amateur Championship
 - Leading Amateur at Victorian Women's Open
 - 2014 Victorian Women's Champion of Champions
 - 2014 Champions Trophy
 - Victorian Junior Masters
 - Murray River Junior Masters
 - SAJG Signature Tournament
 - VGL Championship
 - 2.2 If there is more than one Champion during this period from a club, district, or event, then they must enter their most recent Champion.
 - 2.3 If a player is a Champion of more than one club and/or event and/or District, she may represent the clubs, event/s and Districts she is the Champion of, so long as the Club or District she is representing completes the nominated entry form and pays the stated entry fee. Players entering the Champion of Champions as a State Champion need not pay the nominated entry fee.
 - 2.4 In 2015, the Champion of Champions is being played concurrently with the Victorian Salver. Players competing in the Champion of Champions with GA handicaps between 9.5 and 24.4 are also eligible to win the Victorian Salver trophies provided they pay the designated Victorian Salver entry fee.
- ## 3. ENTRIES
- 3.1 The entry fee is \$60.00 (incl. GST) paid by the Club, unless player is a State Champion (see Tournament Condition 2.3). Entry fee must be paid at time of entry.
 - 3.2 Golf Victoria shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
 - 3.3 Entries shall only be made on the official entry form or online at www.golfvic.org.au.
 - 3.4 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at www.golfvic.org.au approximately one week before the event.

4. TROPHIES

- Trophies will be awarded to:
- Winner – Victorian Champion of Champions
 - Runner-up
 - Winner – Best 36 Hole Gross score
 - Joan Fisher Trophy
 - Winner – Best 36 Hole Nett score
 - Gwenda Anderson Trophy

5. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of Golf Victoria representatives and the Match Committee of the Club upon whose course the rounds are being played. In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round.

6. REFUND POLICY

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded providing notification is received within **three working days** prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical Certificate).

7. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under Championships & Events → Resources → GV Motorised Transport for the return form and more information. **Exemption:** Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Golf carts are at the player's own expense and **MUST** be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Victoria cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player **ONLY** when sufficient carts are available.
