About

The 2015 Men's and Women's Port Phillip Open Pre-Qualifying round will be contested for approximately 10 male and 5 female positions into the Championship proper. The round will be played over 18-hole stroke-play at the Commonwealth Golf Club on the afternoon of Wednesday 10 December. Ties for the final qualifying positions shall be decided by a hole by hole play-off immediately following the pre-qualifying round at Commonwealth Golf Club.

- (i) For the pre-qualifying round only, range balls and lunches will be at the expense of each competitor. Please note that irons only on the practice tee. Woods are **not** permitted, but can be hit in the nets.
- (ii) Full results and a list of successful qualifiers will be made available on the Golf Victoria website from 7:30pm on Wednesday 9 December. Players that are successful in progressing through to the Championship proper will be notified of their 1st and 2nd round tee times via email.
- (iii) **Practice rounds will not be permitted at Commonwealth Golf Club prior to the pre-qualifying round**

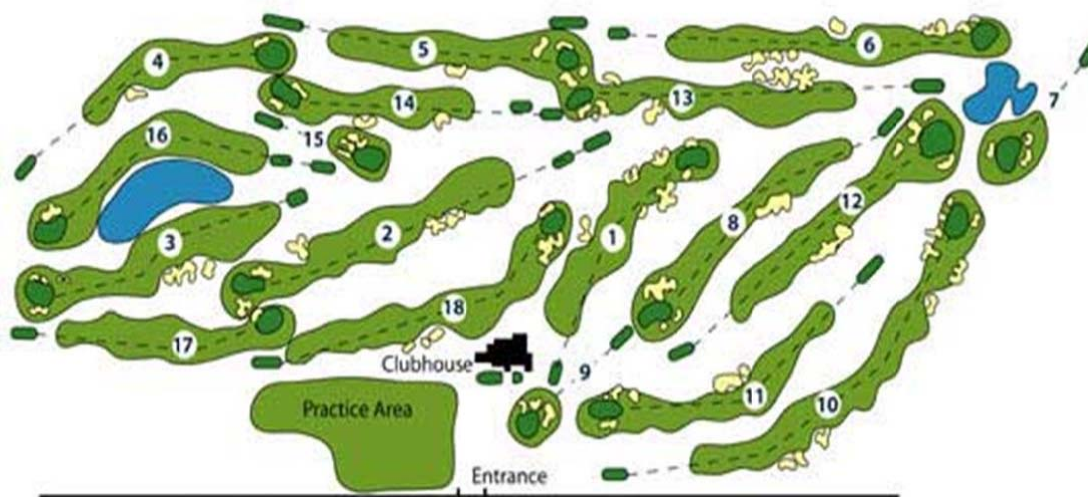

Scratchings

Any player wishing to scratch prior to Wednesday 9 December must ring GV Tournaments on (03) 8545 6214 (Stephanie). To withdraw on the day of play please call the GV mobile on **0417 338 567 (David)**.

Refunds

Players unsuccessful in qualifying through to the Port Phillip Open will have \$100 of their entry fee refunded.



Registration

All competitors are required to report to Golf Victoria representatives inside the clubhouse upon arrival at the course. Players must then be present on the appropriate tee **no later than 10 minutes prior the tee time**.

Scorecards

All score cards are to be returned to the registration area situated in the clubhouse immediately at the conclusion of play.

Dress Regulations

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following:

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Gentlemen must wear long socks or white short socks with such shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

Golf Footwear

Players are requested to note that soft spikes are mandatory.

Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, pitch marks are to be repaired, and bunkers raked following play at each course. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GV Code of Conduct.

Motorised Carts

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under *Rules & Handicapping* → *Motorised Transport* for the return form and more information. **Exemption:** Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Golf carts are at the player's own expense and **MUST** be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Victoria cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player **ONLY** when sufficient carts are available.

Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.
