## CONDITIONS OF BOOKING & PLAY

1. GolfLink numbers must be advised and the entrance fee paid at the time of entry, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. No entries will be accepted without GolfLink numbers and payment.
2. The Kooyonga Golf Club reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving an explanation. Any entrant may withdraw and have their entrance fee refunded provided notification is received by 5.00pm 5 February 2016. After 5 February 2016 the entrance fee may be refunded if the booking can be filled.
3. **Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of the Kooyonga Golf Club. No denim clothing or tracksuits may be worn on any of the Club's property. On the course and practice facilities, females may wear long slacks, skirts or shorts provided they are not abbreviated, tight fitting or in the nature of leggings. All golf shoes must be fitted with soft spikes. Hats / caps are not to be worn in the clubhouse. The Committee may deny any person not complying with the dress standards or course requirements access to any of the Club's facilities.**
4. The field will be strictly limited to 128 entrants.
5. Play will be from the red tees.
6. The hole allocations will be published by 12 February 2016 and sent by email to participants. Hole allocations will also be on the Kooyonga Golf Club website.
7. The Rules governing this event shall be the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules enforced by the Kooyonga Golf Club Inc.
8. Competitors must start at the appointed time. Rule 6-3 will apply.
9. The Match Committee of the Kooyonga Golf Club will make playing arrangements and be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play. In the event of a tie the Golf Australia count back guidelines will be applied.
10. Rule 6-7 (Undue Delay; Slow Play) will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be applied to players in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to imposition of penalties.
11. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
12. Golf Australia conditions in relation to Code of Conduct apply.
13. A person may not bring on to the course any motorised vehicles. A limited number of motorised carts are available at a cost for golfers with medical certificates.
14. Please notify the Club of any dietary requirements at the time of entry.
