COMPETITOR CONDITIONS

1. The Southern Ladies Challenge Bowl will be played on Monday 8th February 2016 over 18 holes.
2. A maximum field of 120 players will be eligible to play in the event. Only one entry per Club is permitted unless approved by the Ladies Committee.
3. Entry Fee must be paid at the time of entry.
4. The event is open to amateurs only who are members of a Golf Australia Club and the Ladies Committee of Southern Golf Club have the right to refuse the entry of any person and or team without being requested to give any reason for such refusal.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with the Local Rules and any Temporary Local Rules of Southern Golf Club on the day of play. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Ladies Committee of Southern Golf Club.
6. The Ladies Committee will make all arrangements and have full power to alter or make any variation in the conditions should they deem it desirable.
7. The competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Ladies Committee may arrange and they will have the power to select a marker for any competitor whose fellow competitor is not at their starting tee by the scheduled starting time.
8. The Ladies Committee may, in special circumstances, permit any competitor who is not ready to start at their appointed time, to start at a later time.
9. The Ladies Committee, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, may shorten the contest or reschedule it to another day.
 - In the event of a tie for the individual events, the winners will be decided by a countback using the method recommended by Golf Australia.
 - In the event of a tie for the Challenge Bowl, a countback will be used, combining the three team members scores using the method recommended by Golf Australia.
10. Mobile phones may be carried on the course but must be turned off or switched to silent and may be used in an emergency situation or to contact a Rules Official.
